On November 16, 2018, Landis+Gyr filed electronically the attached Motion for Intervention ("Motion") in the above-captioned matter which was filed by Public Service Electric and Gas Company (PSE&G) on October 11, 2018. A hard copy of the Motion was stamped "received" by the Board on November 23, 2019.

On April 1, 2020, Commissioner Holden issued a Pre-hearing order deciding motions for intervention and participation filed in the matter. For some reason, the Motion filed by
