LANDIS+GYR TECHNOLOGY, INC. MOTION FOR INTERVENTION

Landis+Gyr Technology, Inc. ("Landis+Gyr"), by its undersigned counsel, pursuant to the Order issued by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board") on October 29, 2018, hereby formally requests that the Board grant Landis+Gyr's request herein to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. Landis+Gyr respectfully submits that all factors for intervenor status set forth in N.J.A.C. 1:1-16.3 support granting this motion. Landis+Gyr states in support thereof the following:

1. Landis+Gyr is a leading global provider of integrated energy management solutions for the utility sector. Landis+Gyr offers products and services that address complex industry challenges, including multi-purpose Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) network platforms for advanced metering and grid modernization, as well as, smart metering, distribution network sensing and automation tools, load control, and analytics solutions that form the foundation of a smarter grid.

2. The Board's decision in this proceeding is expected to have an effect on Landis+Gyr's

business operations in PSE&G's service territory, but also potentially serve as a precedent for

AMI deployment in other utility service territories across the state and other jurisdictions across

the country. Landis+Gyr will therefore likely be substantially, directly and specifically affected

by the relief provided herein.

3. PSE&G's CEF-EC filing proposes the deployment of AMI throughout the utility's

electric service territory. Specifically, PSE&G proposes to offer and install approximately 2.2

million advanced (or "smart") meters over five years. Accordingly, Landis+Gyr has a significant

interest in the Board's review of PSE&G's CEF-EC filing as it pertains to the benefit of AMI

implementation to energy efficiency, customer savings, system reliability, and the environment,

among other things.

4. Landis+Gyr's expertise and interest is distinct from other parties in this case. Thus, no

other party will represent the interests or insights of Landis+Gyr in this case.

5. Landis+Gyr will coordinate its representation with other similarly situated entities in this

docket to the extent it finds such action appropriate.
