The Board of Public Utility's decision in this proceeding is likely to have precedential effect and impact not only the Petitioner herein and its customers, but also New Jersey's other electric utilities. The advanced metering infrastructure ("AMI") and associated cost recovery issues that will be addressed in this case may have an impact on PSE&G by establishing precedent. - 8. PSE&G will abide by the schedule set for this proceeding, to the extent one has been entered.
 - 9. The granting of this Motion will not cause undue delay or confusion.

WHEREFORE, PSE&G respectfully requests an Order: (1) granting it rights as a Participant in this matter pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 1:1-16.6, and (2) providing such further relief in connection therewith as is deemed reasonable, just, and consistent with the foregoing.
