The undersigned is Assistant General Counsel to Atlantic City Electric Company ("ACE" or the "Company") in connection with the above referenced matter.

After conferring with the parties to this proceeding, the Company provides this letter to respectfully request a suspension of the Procedural Schedule embodied in the December 21, 2020 Prehearing Order Setting Procedural Schedule, Ruling on Motions to Participate and Intervene, and Extending the 180 Day Review Period in this matter. Specifically, the Company's request includes suspension of the deadline for the filing of Intervenor/Rate Counsel testimony. The purpose of the suspension is to facilitate on-going settlement discussions.

Although the settlement discussions are continuing, ACE is optimistic that this proceeding can be resolved without the need for further litigation. The parties nevertheless reserve the right to request a further/amended Procedural Schedule at a later date, in the event one is required.
