The undersigned attorney is Assistant General Counsel to Atlantic City Electric Company ("ACE" or the "Company") in connection with the above matter. On February 16, 2021, ACE requested that the filing date for Rate Counsel and Intervenor testimony be moved to March 10, 2021.
