## IN THE MATTER OF SOLAR SUCCESSOR INCENTIVE PROGRAM PURSUANT TO P.L. 2018, C.17 – Docket No. QO20020184

Pursuant to the "Open Public Meetings Act", N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq., the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("NJBPU" or "Board") hereby provides notice that a Public Meeting will be conducted in the above referenced matter on Friday, April 30, 2021 at 10:00 a.m.

The Board is completing a comprehensive revision of New Jersey's solar energy incentive programs in accordance with the Clean Energy Act. The upcoming establishment of the New Jersey Solar Successor Program (Successor Program) is the culmination of more than two years of stakeholder engagement and program development to transition from New Jersey's legacy SREC program to the creation of a long-term, durable solar incentive program.

On April 7, 2021, the Board <u>issued a Notice</u> releasing Staff's **New Jersey Solar Successor Program Straw Proposal**, which details preliminary recommendations for the Successor Program and launches the last set of stakeholder sessions in this solar transition to be held between late April and early May. To complement these workshops, stakeholders are also invited to speak directly with the Board Commissioners at this Public Meeting.
