**RE:** In the Matter of the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities' Response to the COVID-19 Pandemic

Dear Secretary Camacho-Welch:

Pursuant to an Order Authorizing Establishment of a Regulatory Asset for Incremental COVID-19 Related Expenses (the "Order"), approved and issued by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (the "Board") on July 2, 2020, New Jersey's regulated utilities were authorized to defer COVID-19-related incremental costs and related offsets into a regulatory asset.

#### As stated in the Order:

the Board **HEREBY AUTHORIZES** each of the State's regulated utilities to create a COVID-19-related regulatory asset by deferring on their books and records the prudently incurred incremental costs related to COVID-19 beginning on March 9, 2020, and through September 30, 2021, or 60 days after Governor Murphy issues an order, declaration, proclamation, or similar announcement that the Public Health Emergency is no longer in effect, or in the absence of such an order, declaration, proclamation or similar announcement, 60 days from the time the Public Health Emergency automatically terminates pursuant to N.J.S.A. 26:13-3(b), whichever is later.

In compliance with the Order and consistent with its terms, Atlantic City Electric Company ("ACE" or the "Company") has tracked such prudently incurred incremental costs and includes the most current quarterly report as **Attachment 1**. ACE will continue reporting these relevant costs on a quarterly basis.

The COVID-19-related incremental costs included in ACE's report include lost late payment revenues, personal protective equipment, cleaning/sanitizing costs, hospital feeder inspections, and other costs. Additionally, the attached report includes informational data regarding aging of accounts receivable balances, as well as write-off information and number of reconnected customers, and a Cost Savings (Offsets) tab. Like other uncollectible expenses, the COVID-19-related incremental uncollectible expenses will be addressed in the Company's next Societal Benefits Charge update/reconciliation filing and not included in the COVID-19 regulatory asset.

Considerations and costs related to the COVID-19 Pandemic remain very fluid, as do any incremental offsets. The Board has recently ordered changes to the Fresh Start and Universal Service Fund programs and required compliance by October 1, 2021. In addition, working group meetings continue and motions have been filed by certain utilities in this docket. Accordingly, ACE reserves the right to add additional incremental costs to this report or future quarterly reports.

Consistent with the Order issued by the Board in connection with *In the Matter of the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities' Response to the COVID-19 Pandemic for a Temporary Waiver of Requirements for Certain Non-Essential Obligations*, BPU Docket No. EO20030254, Order dated March 19, 2020, this letter and its attachment(s) are being electronically filed with the Secretary of the Board and the New Jersey Division of Rate Counsel.
