4. The issues that will be addressed in this request for approval Smart Energy Network ("SEN") and other relief provided herein will directly and specifically affect SJG. The Board of Public

Utility's decision in this proceeding will have precedential effect and impact not only the Petitioner herein and its customers, but also New Jersey's other utilities—including SJG.

- 5. The customers and the operations of SJG are distinct from those of other parties and participants in this case. Thus, no other party or participant will represent the interests of SJG in this case.
- 6. SJG has a history of coordinating its activities in dockets at the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities with those of other utilities where appropriate. SJG will coordinate its representation with other similarly situated parties or participants in this docket to the extent appropriate.
- 7. Due to SJG's experience in the gas industry, its participation in this proceeding is likely to add constructively to the proceeding.
- 8. SJG will abide by the schedule set for this proceeding, to the extent one has been entered.
  - 9. The granting of this Motion will not cause undue delay or confusion.

**WHEREFORE**, SJG respectfully requests an Order: (1) granting it rights as a Participant in this matter pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 1:1-16.6, and (2) providing such further relief in connection therewith as is deemed reasonable, just, and consistent with the foregoing.
