**RE:** In the Matter of the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities' Response to the COVID-19 Pandemic BPU Docket No. AO20060471

Dear Secretary Camacho-Welch:

Pursuant to an Order Authorizing Establishment of a Regulatory Asset for Incremental COVID-19 Related Expenses (the "Order"), approved and issued by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (the "Board") in the above-referenced docket on July 2, 2020, New Jersey's regulated utilities were authorized to defer COVID-19-related incremental costs and related offsets into a regulatory asset.

In compliance with the Order and consistent with its terms, Aqua New Jersey ("ANJ" or the "Company") has tracked such prudently incurred incremental costs and includes the most current quarterly report as **Attachment 1**. ANJ will continue reporting these relevant costs on a quarterly basis.

Among the COVID-19-related incremental costs included in the Company's report are the following: lost/waived reconnection fee revenues, personal protective equipment costs, cleaning/sanitizing costs, employee related costs, bad debt, other supply costs and costs related to Customer Bill of Rights mailing. Additionally, the attached quarterly report includes data regarding aging of accounts receivable balances used to develop the estimate for bad debt, as well as a calculation of off-setting cost savings. As the Board is well aware, the COVID-19 pandemic is a very fluid situation that has the ability to impact the Company's performance in a multitude of ways. As such, Aqua respectfully reserves the right to add additional incremental costs to this or future quarterly reports.

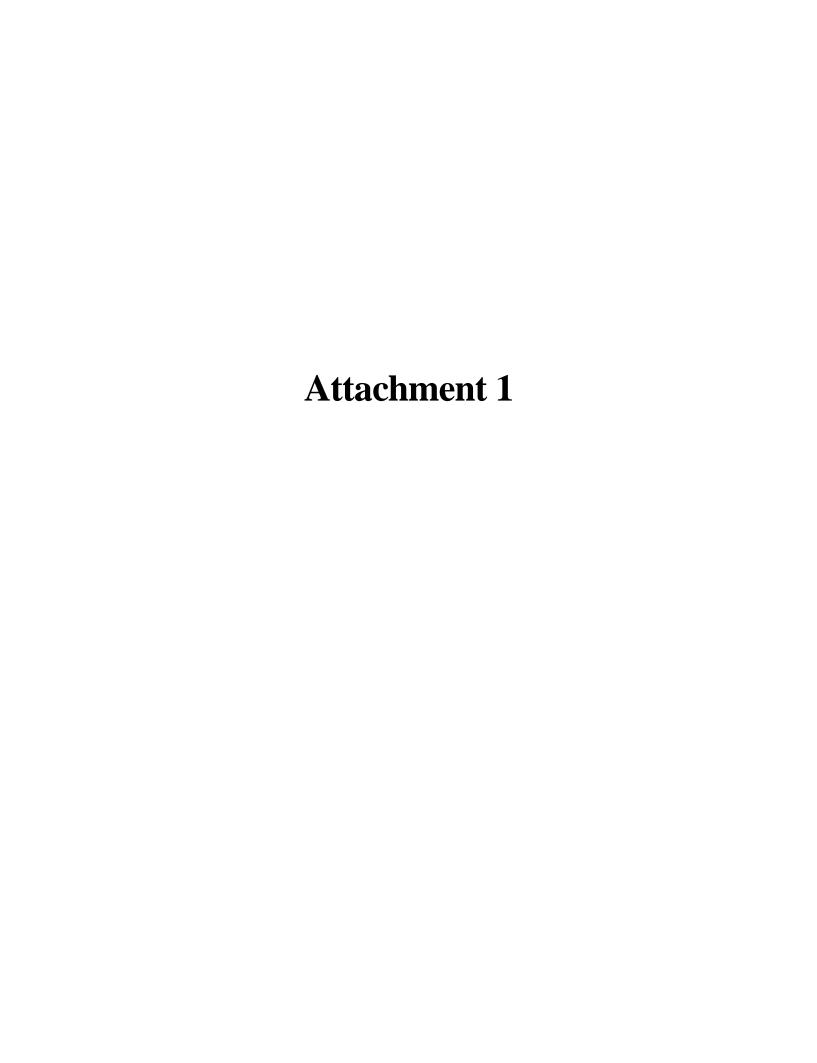
