



Notice is hereby given that on August 9, 2013, Shore Water Company (Company) filed a Petition with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (Board) in Docket No. WR13080715, together with revised tariff sheets containing increased rates for water service and other revised terms and conditions. The changes were proposed to become effective for service rendered on and after thirty (30) days from the filing date of the Company's Petition, or at such later date as the Board may determine. The proposed new rates would yield additional operating revenues of approximately \$162,383.00 or 31.151% over current base rates and are required so that Shore Water Company may make necessary capital improvements and repairs to its sixty-one (61) year old water system; and to reflect the Company having incurred extraordinary storm-related expenses and having lost a portion of its customer base; and as further described in the Petition.

The percentage increase is proposed to be allocated as follows:
