RE: Request of DSCI Holdings Corporation to Cancel its Authority to Provide Competitive Local Exchange and Interexchange Services and Existing New Jersey Tariffs

Dear Secretary Sheehan:

On December 17, 2014, the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board") approved a Petition for Authority filed by DSCI, LLC ("DSCI") in Docket No. TE14091038, effective December 26, 2014, and a Petition for approval of a transfer of assets from DSCI Holdings Corporation ("DSCI Holdings") to DSCI filed by DSCI Holdings in Docket No. TM14030237, effective December 29, 2014.

The Order in Docket No. TM14030237 directed DSCI Holdings, following completion of the transaction and once all customers have been transferred, to surrender its authority in New Jersey to the Board and to file a final annual report. The Order in Docket No. TE14091038 directed DSCI, LLC to file a tariff prior to commencing service.

On or about December 24, 2014, DSCI Holdings submitted its final annual report. DSCI Holdings understands that its unpaid annual assessments on gross intrastate revenues through December 31, 2014 remain owing, and that DSCI will receive the invoices for DSCI Holding's FY2015 and FY 2106 assessments on DSCI Holdings' gross intrastate revenues as of December 31, 2013 and December 31, 2014 respectively. On March 19, 2015, at the request of staff, DSCI Holdings also filed its Statement of Gross Intrastate Revenues from Operations for the CY 2014.

DSCI, LLC submitted its tariffs on February 19, 2015 to be effective on March 23, 2015 in Docket No. TT15020242. As of the effective date of the tariffs, DSCI Holdings will have completed the transfer of customers to DSCI, LLC. Upon completion of this transaction DSCI Holdings will no longer be providing service nor have customers in New Jersey.

Accordingly, pursuant to the Board's directives, DSCI Holdings files this letter to surrender its authority to provide competitive local exchange and interexchange services granted on February 23, 2005 in Docket No. TE0411410 and to withdraw its existing tariffs.


