Atlantic City Electric Company 2015/2016 Annual Compliance Filing for the Universal Service Fund Program Factor Within the Societal Benefits Charge Rate

Dear Secretary Asbury:

Pursuant to the Board of Public Utilities' ("Board") Order dated June 22, 2005, an annual compliance filing for prospective Universal Service Fund ("USF") rates is required to be made on or by July 1st of each year. Enclosed, therefore, for filing in connection with the above-captioned USF proceeding are an original and eleven (11) copies of Atlantic City Electric Company's ("ACE" or the "Company") 2015/2016 USF compliance filing. Kindly acknowledge receipt of this filing by date stamping the enclosed copy of this letter and returning same in the self-addressed, postage-prepaid envelope provided.

In order to streamline the Board's review and processing of this proceeding, the State's electric and gas utilities, consistent with past practice, have presented supporting documentation for joint recommendations within the compliance filing that is being filed by Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("PSE&G") (the "Joint Compliance Filing"). The Joint Compliance Filing documents ACE's support of a change in the current Statewide electric USF rate on and after October 1, 2015.

Based upon (i) the results known to date for the 2014/2015 USF program year and (ii) the available estimates for the 2015/2016 USF program year, it is proposed that USF rates should be set to recover \$176.0 million on a Statewide basis. The details for the recovery of this \$176.0 million are set forth on the template appended hereto as Attachment A. Additionally, based upon the available estimates to date for the 2015/2016 Lifeline program year, it is proposed that Lifeline rates should be set to recover \$74.2 million on a Statewide basis. The details for the recovery of this amount are also set forth on the template appended hereto as Attachment A.

In accordance with the Board's July 16, 2003 Order, the Company has attached proposed tariff sheets, effective October 1, 2015 (Attachment B), proposing to increase its electric USF program factor from .1863 cents per kWh (.1993 cents per kWh, including Sales and Use Tax ["SUT"]) to .2098 cents per kWh (.2245 cents per kWh, including SUT) and decrease its Lifeline charge from .0690 cents per kWh (.0738 cents per kWh, including SUT) to .0677 cents per kWh (.0724 cents per kWh, including SUT).

In addition, by Order dated June 21, 2010, the Board approved separate stipulations by and among each utility, Board Staff, and the Division of Rate Counsel to defer and seek annual recovery of USF-related administrative costs in each annual USF Compliance Filing beginning with the 2010 - 2011 USF Compliance Filing. Attachment A of the Joint Compliance Filing submitted by PSE&G includes ACE's actual deferred administrative costs from July 1, 2014 through April 30, 2015 and estimated administrative costs for May through September 2015. Within the Joint Compliance Filing, the electric distribution companies request full recovery of their deferred administrative costs in 2015/2016 USF rates and Lifeline rates in the month following Board approval of such rates from funds disbursed to the utilities by the USF Trust Account.

Since ACE's proposed USF rate is increasing and the proposed Lifeline rate is decreasing for 2015/2016, the Company understands that public hearings will be required. A Notice of Public Hearing will follow under separate cover.

The Company respectfully requests that the Board accept this filing and issue an Order approving a change in the current Statewide electric USF rate as outlined herein for electric service on and after October 1, 2015.
