Notification of Discontinuance of Sprint Wireline Long-distance Services and Associated Features by Sprint Communications Company L.P.

Dear Secretary Asbury:

Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Sprint Communications"), through its undersigned counsel, hereby notifies the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (the "Board") of its intention to discontinue its provision of Sprint wireline consumer longdistance services and associated features. The specific Sprint wireline consumer longdistance services and associated features being discontinued are Message Telecommunications Service (i.e., 1+ long distance) ("MTS"), FŌNCARD, Directory Assistance, and Operator Service (collectively, the "Sprint Services"), as well as all consumer pricing plans associated with the Sprint Services. This notice does not apply to business services.

Sprint Communications contemporaneously with this notice is providing written notice to affected New Jersey customers². As required by Federal Communications Commission's (the "FCC") requirements in Section 63.71 of the FCC's Rules³, a copy of the Sprint Communications Application to the FCC dealing with this matter is being mailed to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications for the Secretary of Defense and the Governor of each state

where the discontinuance of service is proposed. A copy of the Sprint Communications filing being made with the FCC is provided to this Board.⁴

Sprint Communications is planning on discontinuing Sprint wireline consumer long-distance services and associated features in New Jersey on September 19, 2015 or as soon as allowed by the FCC if that date is later. The Company has provided all required notices to customers and this Board. The impacted customers are being directed to the incumbent local service provider in the area to choose an alternative long distance provider as Sprint cannot change a customer's PIC per industry regulations. A number and email link for existing customers to contact Sprint Communications with questions concerning Sprint's decommission of long distance service as well as and a web site where Frequently Asked Questions will be posted has been provided in the customer notice.

As required by N.J.A.C. § 14:10-12.3(b)(2)(i) - (xv), Sprint Communications provides the following information constituting its exit plan.

- i. Tariff: Sprint's services were detariffed in 2014.
- ii. Initial Customer Notice Letter: please see June 15, 2015 customer notice letter provided as Attachment 1 to the Notice. Second Customer Notice Letter: a second notice letter to end users will be mailed on or about July 19, 2015. The letter will conform with the appropriate sample letter contained in the appendices to N.J.A.C. § 14:10-12.
- iii. Final Service Date/Departure Date: Sprint Communications will discontinue service on September 19, 2015 or as soon thereafter as the necessary regulatory approvals can be obtained. Customer cut-off date: Sprint Communications has advised customers to select a new provider by no later than August 19, 2015.

- vii. Services Description: Sprint wireline consumer long-distance services and associated features being discontinued are Message Telecommunications Service (i.e., 1+ long distance) ("MTS"), FŌNCARD, Directory Assistance, and Operator Service (collectively, the "Sprint Services"), as well as all consumer pricing plans associated with the Sprint Services.
- viii. The number of end users who will no longer receive service from Sprint Communications: 2,234 as of June 2, 2015.
- ix. An explanation of any transfer of assets or control of assets that requires Board approval, which is planned by the departing TSP. Not applicable.
- x. Plans for dealing with end user deposits, credits, and/or termination liabilities or penalties: None of the impacted customer accounts for New Jersey involve deposits. No penalties or termination liability will be assessed as a result of this termination of service. All remaining accounts receivable or accounts payable will be addressed by Sprint Communications Business Care Department. A toll free number (800-877-4646) will be maintained for customers to contact Sprint Communications and discuss any concerns.
- xi. Plans for unlocking the E-911 database: Not applicable.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 14:10-12.7, Sprint hereby requests that Board Staff waive the requirements for submission of end user lists set forth in N.J.A.C. 14:10-12.7 and 14:10-12.8. The waiver request is submitted for competitive reasons. Staff should waive the requirements because the customer information is sensitive competitive information. Other providers may utilize a customer list to market services other than long distance services to the departing customers. Sprint takes significant precautions to not disclose sensitive customer information, and disclosure of a customer list for the discontinuance of residential long distance service has no benefits that outweigh the harms of formatting and providing the sensitive competitive information.

On September 19, 2015, or as soon thereafter as the necessary regulatory approvals can be obtained, Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Sprint") will no longer provide Sprint wireline consumer long distance services and associated features in each of the 50 United States, the District of Columbia, Guam, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands. The specific Sprint wireline consumer long distance services and associated features being discontinued include all domestic and international 1+ dialing from pre-subscribed accounts and casual caller accounts, as well as Operator Services, Directory Assistance, Directory Assistance Calling, FÖNCARD and all consumer pricing plans associated with the services listed above.

Due to changing market conditions, Sprint has determined that it should discontinue the Sprint wireline consumer long distance services and associated features described above. This discontinuance impacts all of your Sprint 1+ dialed calls. If you choose to have a pre-subscribed long distance carrier, you will need to transition your service by September 19, 2015. In order to do so, you will need to choose another long distance service provider. Note that a new service provider may require time to provision service to you. As a result, we strongly recommend that you select a provider no later than August 19, 2015. If you are not certain of your options for obtaining replacement pre-subscribed long distance service, you should contact your local telephone service provider and ask which carriers are accepting pre-subscribed customers. Sprint will no longer carry any consumer wireline long-distance calls (both interstate and intrastate) after September 19, 2015. This discontinuance does not impact any Sprint wireless services that you have.

Sprint has notified the Federal Communications Commission and filed an Application with the Board of Public Utilities (BPU) regarding its proposed discontinuance of service. The FCC will normally authorize this proposed discontinuance of service (or reduction or impairment) unless it is shown that customers would be unable to receive service or a reasonable substitute from another carrier or that the public convenience and necessity is otherwise adversely affected. Pursuant to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214(a), and Section 63.19 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.19, Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Sprint") hereby notifies the Commission that it plans to discontinue all Sprint wireline consumer long-distance services, including all outbound international services and features associated therewith, effective September 19, 2015. Discontinuance of the domestic Sprint Services in question will eliminate the ability of customers located in each of the United States, the District of Columbia, Guam, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands to place international calls. Sprint provides these international services and features pursuant to a number of International Section 214

As outlined in the attached section 63.71 application, the specific domestic long-distance services and associated features in question are Message Telecommunications Service (i.e., 1+ long distance), FÖNCARD, Directory Assistance, and Operator Service (collectively, the "Sprint Services"), as well as all consumer pricing plans associated with the Sprint Services. Sprint is the Telecommunications Relay Service ("TRS") contractor in 35 states and territories and is bound under these contracts to offer Sprint Casual Caller TRS interexchange service to TRS users that are not PICed to a carrier. SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION

Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Sprint" or "Applicant") hereby seeks authorization, pursuant to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"), 47 U.S.C. § 214(a), and Section 63.71 of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC" or "Commission"), 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, to discontinue its provision of Sprint wireline consumer long-distance services and associated features. The specific Sprint wireline consumer long-distance services and associated features being discontinued are Message Telecommunications Service (*i.e.*, 1+ long distance) ("MTS"), FÖNCARD, Directory Assistance, and Operator Service (collectively, the "Sprint Services"), as well as all consumer pricing plans associated with the Sprint Services.

In response to changing market conditions, Sprint has decided to terminate its provision of the Sprint Services. On January 5, 2015, Sprint received authority to cease offering the Sprint

Sprint also will cease to provide its outbound international services and features. A copy of this filing is being provided to the International Bureau as an attachment to its notice filed pursuant to Section 63.19 of the Commission's rules.

Sprint is the Telecommunications Relay Service ("TRS") contractor in 35 states and territories and is bound under these contracts to offer Sprint Casual Caller TRS interexchange service to TRS users that are not PICed to a carrier. Sprint is not seeking to discontinue Casual Caller service to TRS system users; rather, Sprint will continue to provide Casual Caller service to TRS system users in states where Sprint is the TRS service provider.

Services to new customers.³ At this time, Sprint plans to discontinue its provision of the Sprint Services to its remaining customers effective September 19, 2015, or as soon thereafter as the necessary regulatory approvals are obtained. The proposed discontinuance will not result in material harm to the affected customers because they easily can obtain alternative services from other wireline interexchange carriers. Customers also may purchase substitute long-distance services and features from wireless carriers such as Sprint or from a host of other alternative providers such as interconnected voice over Internet protocol providers.

The Applicant provides the following information pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules:

- Name and Address of Carrier: Sprint Communications Company L.P. is located at 6200 Sprint Parkway, Overland Park, Kansas 66251.
- 2. <u>Date of Planned Service Discontinuance</u>, <u>Reduction</u>, or <u>Impairment</u>: The Applicant plans to discontinue its provision of the Sprint Services described above effective September 19, 2015, or as soon thereafter in each state as the necessary regulatory approvals can be obtained. The Applicant understands that this Application will be granted automatically on the 31st day after public notice of its filing, unless the Commission notifies the Applicant to the contrary.

See Comments Invited on Application of Sprint Communications Company L.P. to Discontinue Domestic Telecommunications Services, Public Notice, WC Docket No. 14-243, 29 FCC Rcd 14711 (2014) (DA 14-1777). Note that Sprint's application sought authority to "grandfather" both the Sprint Services and certain services offered to business customers. The instant application relates solely to the consumer Sprint Services outlined above; Sprint will seek to discontinue the business services in question at a later time.

- Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected: Sprint proposes to discontinue the
 provision of the Sprint Services in each of the United States, the District of Columbia,
 Guam, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands.
- 4. <u>Brief Description of Type of Service Affected</u>: The Sprint Services affected by this discontinuance include all MTS, Operator, FŌNCARD, and Directory Assistance services and features provided to Sprint consumers, with the exception of Casual Caller services provided to TRS users in states where Sprint holds the TRS service provider contract.⁴
- 5. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers: In accordance with Section 63.71(a), Sprint provided written notice, by first class mail, to its affected subscribers between June 15, 2015 and June 19, 2015. A sample copy of the notice letter provided to customers is attached hereto as Attachment A.
- Whether the Carrier is Considered Dominant or Non-Dominant with Respect to the Service to Be Discontinued, Reduced, or Impaired: Applicant is considered nondominant with respect to the affected services.

In accordance with Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, a copy of this Application is being mailed to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications for the Secretary of Defense and to the public utility commission and the Governor of each state in which the discontinuance of service is proposed.

The public convenience and necessity will not be adversely affected by the discontinuance of the Sprint Services and features in question. All customers have been provided notice that affords them ample time to acquire one of the many substitute services that


