Dear Secretary Asbury:

On behalf of Atlantic City Electric Company ("ACE" or the "Company"), enclosed please find USF reports that are being filed electronically with the Secretary of the Board and the Division of Audits for the quarter ending June 30, 2015. The reports are: (1) the Second Quarter 2015 USF Financial Report (Attachment 1); and (2) the Table 3 - Second Quarter 2015 New Jersey USF/APP Data (Attachment 2). In addition, attached as Attachment 3 is updated data from the Table 3 (New Jersey USF/APP) that was included with ACE's First Quarter 2015 report (filed on or about May 1, 2015).

In the last quarterly report, the Company reported that, on or about January 5, 2015, ACE converted to a new SAP-based customer information system called Solution One. Although every effort was made to minimize disruption to ACE's customers and its reporting obligations, the Company has experienced some issues in gathering data for certain reports. The First and Second Quarter USF/APP data spreadsheet are two such reports. As noted in the First Quarter 2015 Report, certain information that would normally be reflected in the USF/APP spreadsheet was unavailable. This includes data related to "Distribution of USF Benefits," "Distribution of Arrearage Forgiveness," and "Distribution of USF Retail Bills." The Company's Customer Care Support Team is continuing to cull the data. You will note that, in this Second Quarter Report,

some of the data has been adjusted. It is anticipated that all adjustments will be made by the end of the Third Quarter and will be reflected in the Third Quarter Report. ACE regrets any inconvenience.
