Raritan-Flemington Energy Procurement Cooperative (RFEPC) Community Energy Aggregation Program Draft Request for Proposal (RFP) and Master Performance Agreement (MPA)

Dear Ms. Izzo:

Please find attached, on behalf of the Township of Raritan, Hunterdon County, New Jersey, and the Borough of Flemington, Hunterdon County, New Jersey, in accordance with the requirements of N.J.A.C. 14:4-6.6 (i) and (l), three (3) copies of the draft bidding documents, including the Request for Proposals or "RFP" and the draft form of Master Performance Agreement or "MPA" between the selected supplier and the Township, in connection with the Raritan-Flemington Energy Procurement Cooperative Community Energy Aggregation (RFEPC CEA) program. The participating Municipalities are currently served by Jersey Central Power & Light (JCP&L) with approximately 8,500 residential accounts. These documents are being submitted for Board Staff's review and comment in accordance with the above-cited Government Energy Aggregation rules.

The Township of Raritan passed Ordinance No. 14-14, and the Borough of Flemington passed Ordinance No. 2014-22, authorizing the creation of the RFEPC CEA program, pursuant to the Government Energy Aggregation Act of 2003 – P.L. 2003, c24 (N.J.S.A. 48:3-93.1 et. seq.). Pursuant to those Ordinances, the Township of Raritan will serve as Lead Agency of the RFEPC CEA. Gabel Associates has been retained by the Township as its energy agent to assist in the implementation of the RFEPC CEA program and is responsible for the submission of the attached documents (contact information below). The Township plans to issue bids for electric supply on behalf of residential customers in March 2015 and to award a contract to a supplier in April 2015, with power supply service commencing in either July or September 2015.
