Petitioner, Atlantic City Electric Company ("ACE" or "Petitioner"), initiated this proceeding on March 22, 2016, with the filing of a Verified Petition with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (the "Board"). One day later, ACE's ultimate corporate parent, Pepco Holdings, Inc. ("Pepco"), received approval from the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia to complete a proposed merger with Exelon Corporation ("Exelon").¹ The merger of Exelon and Pepco closed on March 23, 2016, and Exelon is now the ultimate corporate parent of ACE.

¹ Approval of the merger of Exelon and Pepco was required by several state and federal regulatory entities, including the Delaware Public Service Commission, the Maryland Public Service Commission, and the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities. The Board approved the merger of Exelon and Pepco by way of an Order Approving [the] Stipulation of Settlement, dated March 6, 2015, in BPU Docket No. EM14060581.


