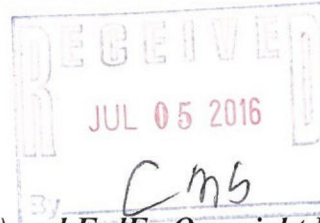

Dear Secretary Asbury:

Please be advised that our office represents Joint Petitioners Charter Communications, Inc. (“Charter”), Time Warner Cable Inc., Time Warner Cable New York City LLC and Time Warner Cable Information Services (New Jersey), LLC (collectively, the “Petitioners”), in the above-captioned matters.¹

Ordering paragraph 10) on page 15 of the Board’s Order Approving Stipulation of Settlement dated March 31, 2016, requires that Petitioners file journal entries to record the transactions approved by the Board. We have been in communication with the Office of Cable Television & Telecommunications (“OCTV&T”) with regard to compliance with ordering paragraph 10), and the OCTV&T has consented to Charter’s request for an extension of time until August 31, 2016, within which to provide said journal entries.


