IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF COMCAST OF GARDEN STATE L.P., FOR A RENEWAL CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL TO CONTINUE TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN A CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEM IN AND FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF CARNEY'S POINT, COUNTY OF SALEM, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

VERIFIED PETITION

Docket No.

Comcast of Garden State L.P. (hereinafter, "Comcast" or "Petitioner"), hereby petitions the Honorable Board of Public Utilities (the "Board"), pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-15, 16 and 17, and N.J.A.C. 14:18-13.6, for renewal of a Certificate of Approval to continue to construct, operate and maintain a cable television system ("System") in the Township of Carney's Point, Salem County, New Jersey ("Township" or "Carney's Point"). In support of its Petition, Petitioner states as follows:

COUNT ONE

1. Comcast, a limited partnership duly organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, is a cable television company subject to the jurisdiction of the Office of Cable Television & Telecommunications ("OCTV&T") and the Board, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1 et seq.

- Comcast maintains its principal offices at 1250 Audubon Park-Berlin Road,
 Cherry Hill, New Jersey 08034.
- 3. On or about April 1, 1982, in Docket No. 8112C-6859, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-17(a) and (b) and N.J.S.A. 48:5A-28(c), the Board issued a Certificate of Approval to Salem County Cable Company, Inc. ("Salem Cable") to provide cable television service in the Township. A copy of said Certificate is on file with the OCTV&T.
- 4. On or about October 12, 1984, in Docket No. 847C-7081, the Board approved the transfer of the System, including the Certificate of Approval with respect to Carney's Point, from Salem Cable to New York Time Cable Company of New Jersey ("NYT").
- 5. On or about July 26, 1989, in Docket No. CM89030342, the Board approved the transfer of the System, including the Certificate of Approval with respect to Carney's Point, from NYT to Garden State Cablevision, L.P. ("Garden State").
- 6. On or about March 12, 1993, in Docket No. CE92070690, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-17(a) and (b) and -28(c), the Board issued a Renewal Certificate of Approval to Garden State to construct, operate and maintain the System in the Township. A copy of said Renewal Certificate of Approval is on file at the OCTV&T.
- 7. On or about January 5, 2000, in Docket No. CM99110855 the Board authorized the merger Lenfest Communications, Inc., which owned a 50% interest in Garden State, with and into a wholly-owned indirect subsidiary of Comcast Corporation, which owned the remaining 50% interest. As a result of said merger, Garden State, later renamed Comcast of Garden State L.P., Petitioner herein, became indirectly wholly-owned by Comcast Corporation.
- 8. On or about October 5, 2004, in Docket No. CE02030195, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-16 and 17, the Board issued a Renewal Certificate of Approval (the "2004 COA") to

Petitioner for the continued construction, operation and maintenance of the System in and for the Township. A copy of said Certificate of Approval is on file at the OCTV&T.

- 9. The 2004 COA, in accordance with its underlying municipal consent ordinance, reflected and included an automatic renewal provision, pursuant to which the Carney's Point franchise would be subject to automatic renewal for a period of ten (10) years following its scheduled expiration date of April 1, 2017.
- 10. As set forth under N.J.A.C. 14:18-13.6(a)(1), applicable to ordinances which provide for automatic renewal, in the absence of notice at least sixty (60) days prior to expiration of the initial term of a franchise from either the cable television company or the municipality of its intention to not renew, a franchise will be deemed to automatically renew.
- 11. Neither the Township nor Comcast provided notice of its intention to not renew the Carney's Point franchise pursuant to N.J.A.C. 14:18-13.6(a)(1) prior to the deadline set forth therein for such action, as confirmed in Comcast's letter to the Township dated March 1, 2017, a copy of which is annexed hereto as Exhibit A. As set forth therein, Comcast further confirmed its intention to exercise its rights under the automatic renewal provision of the 2004 COA.
- 12. As a result of the foregoing, Comcast's franchise in Carney's Point shall be deemed to automatically renew.
- 13. The information pertaining to Comcast on file with the OCTV&T, together with the information contained in its Application for Renewal of a Certificate of Approval ("COA Application") pertaining to the Township, simultaneously filed herewith, all of which is adopted by reference thereto, establishes the requisite criteria for the continued construction, operation and maintenance of the System in the Township by Comcast.

- 14. Comcast possesses the requisite character and suitability for the continued operation of the System. Further, as indicated in the COA Application and other information on file with the OCTV&T, Comcast possesses the necessary financial responsibility and the ability to perform efficiently the proposed services and those services that may be required by the public convenience and necessity during the renewal period. The public convenience and necessity generally support the appropriateness of the issuance of a Renewal Certificate of Approval for the Township to Comcast.
- 15. Comcast has complied, and will continue to comply, with all rules, regulations and laws applicable to the construction, operation and maintenance of the System and will continue to provide safe, adequate and proper cable television service in the Township and the other municipalities in which it serves.

COUNT TWO

- 16. Comcast repeats paragraphs 1 through 15 of COUNT ONE as if set forth fully hereinafter.
- 17. As set forth in the COA Application and other information on file at the OCTV&T, the System operated by Comcast in the Township is part of larger regional cable television systems serving numerous other municipalities contiguous to and surrounding the Township.
- 18. As also set forth in the COA Application and other information on file at the OCTV&T, the Township represents an integral part of the Comcast regional cable television systems serving the counties of Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester and Salem. In addition, the demographics of the Township, as well as its location

of cable television. In particular, they possess and represent the highest degree of technical and

engineering competence, significant administrative experience and a demonstrated

responsiveness to community needs. In addition to the Township, Comcast and other Comcast

affiliates hold Certificates of Approval or other authorization to construct, operate and maintain

cable television systems in more than 340 municipalities in New Jersey, as well as additional

communities in 38 other states and the District of Columbia.

WHEREFORE, Comcast hereby requests that the Honorable Board of Public Utilities

issue to Petitioner a Renewal Certificate of Approval to continue to construct, operate and

maintain a cable television system in and for the Township of Carney's Point.
