Dear Commissioner Solomon:

Pursuant to Legal Specialist Andrea Hart's May 7, 2018 e-mail outlining Staff's draft schedule, attached please find Division of Rate Counsel's ("Rate Counsel") proposed amendment thereto (See Attachment A) in connection with the above referenced matter. As set forth in Rate Counsel's letter dated April 20, 2018 to Your Honor, due to witness availability and the schedules already established (many of which have statutory deadlines) the proposed schedule is not workable. Therefore, Rate Counsel respectfully requests that Your Honor adopt the attached procedural schedule which pushes out the schedule only slightly with hearings set for early December, 2018. These and other small adjustments to Staff's proposed schedule will allow Rate Counsel to fulfill its statutory mandate to represent the interest of the ratepayers in all the proceedings now before the Board.

As outlined in Rate Counsel's April 20, 2018 letter, in the last few weeks the utilities have filed an unprecedented number of cases that both Rate Counsel and the Board Staff must process, many of which have statutory deadlines¹ while the Atlantic IIP case has no statutory deadline. Moreover, the PSE&G Base Rate Case pending at the Office of Administrative Law set hearing dates from September 20 through October 12, 2018. Staff's proposed schedule calls for three Rate Counsel consultants in the Atlantic IIP case responding to discovery at the same time they may be testifying in the PSE&G base rate case. Due to these potential conflicts and existing vacation plans immediately after the Labor Day and Thanksgiving holidays, Rate Counsel respectfully requests that the following changes be made to Staff' recommended schedule:

- 1. The deadline for motions to intervene must be set at a date certain after the scheduling order has been issued by Your Honor. Rate Counsel recommends May 20 as the deadline date for motions to intervene to provide intervenors sufficient time to receive notice and intervene, if necessary.
- 2. Rate Counsel and Intervenor Direct Testimony due date moved two days from September 4th to September 6th.
- 3. Rate Counsel and Intervenor response to discovery due October16 after the PSE&G hearings and moving the rest of the Staff's schedule out two weeks thereafter with evidentiary hearing scheduled for second week of December subject to Your Honor's availability.
- 4. The schedule proposed by Staff does not allow for live surrebuttal. If Rate Counsel is not permitted to offer live surrebuttal, we respectfully request that additional time be added to the schedule to allow for written surrebuttal.

¹I/M/O the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities' Consideration of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, Docket No. AX18010001, et al (12 separate tax cases required by BPU Order to be resolved by July, 2018), several base rate cases that must be resolved in 9 months, several energy efficiency and renewable energy filings pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:3-98.1 that must be resolved in six months as well as several legislative programs, A3724/S2313 (Establishes zero emission certificate program); A3723/S2314 (Establishes and modifies clean energy and energy efficiency programs; modifies State's solar renewable energy portfolio standards) and S1217 (Requires BPU consideration and approval of amended application for qualified wind energy project offshore in certain NJ territorial waters), which, if/when signed by the Governor, will require Rate Counsel and Staff's participation under short and strict statutory deadlines.

Rate Counsel respectfully requests that Your Honor adopt the attached compromise schedule in order to allow a full vetting of the first case filed under the new infrastructure regulation. In light of the already-scheduled hearings and the heavy case load that both Staff and Rate Counsel face in coming months, a two week delay from Staff proposed schedule is reasonable.
