Docket No.

Comcast of South Jersey, LLC ("Comcast" or "Petitioner") hereby petitions the Honorable Board of Public Utilities (the "Board"), pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1 et seq., and N.J.A.C. 14:17-6.7, for modification of the terms and conditions of a municipal consent upon which a Certificate of Approval is based. This Petition is engendered by the agreement of Comcast and the Township of Upper Deerfield ("Township" or "Upper Deerfield") and the modification by the Township of Ordinance No. 424, authorizing Comcast to provide cable television service in and to the Township, as set forth more fully herein. In support of the within Petition, Petitioner states as follows:

MODIFICATION OF MUNICIPAL CONSENT

1. Comcast, a limited liability company duly organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, is a cable television company subject to the jurisdiction of the Office of Cable Television & Telecommunications ("OCTV&T") and the Board, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1 et seq.

- Comcast maintains its principal offices at 1250 Haddonfield-Berlin Road, Cherry Hill, New Jersey 08034.
- 3. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-17(a) and (b) and -28(c), on or about March 7, 1984, in Docket No. 834C-6977, the Board issued to Cablentertainment of New Jersey V ("Cablentertainment") a Certificate of Approval to construct, operate and maintain a cable television system ("System") in the Township.
- 4. On or about December 18, 1986, in Docket No. CM86101185, the Board approved the transfer of the System from Cablentertainment to Sammons Communications of New Jersey, Inc. ("Sammons").
- 5. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-15 and -16, on April 24, 1995, in Docket No. CE94090404, the Board issued a Renewal Certificate of Approval ("Renewal COA") to Sammons. A copy of said Renewal COA is on file at the Board.
- 6. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 424, adopted by the Township on July 7, 1994 (the "1994 Ordinance"), underlying the Renewal COA issued in Docket No. CE94090404, the renewal granted to Sammons was for an initial term of fifteen (15) years, followed by an automatic renewal thereof for an additional term of ten (10) years.
- 7. On or about February 28, 1996, in Docket No. CM95080358, the Board approved the transfer of the System, including its Renewal COA for the Township, from Sammons to Lenfest Atlantic, Inc. ("Lenfest").
- 8. On or about January 6, 2000, in Docket No. CM99110855, the Board approved the merger of Lenfest Communications, Inc., Lenfest's indirect parent, with and into a whollyowned indirect subsidiary of Comcast Corporation. As a result, Lenfest, which subsequently changed its name to Comcast of South Jersey, LLC, Petitioner herein, became a wholly owned

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indirect subsidiary of Comcast Corporation.

- 9. On or about November 30, 2011, in Docket No. CE09030208, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-16 and 17, the Board issued an Automatic Renewal Certificate of Approval ("Automatic Renewal COA") to Petitioner for the continued construction, operation and maintenance of the System in and for the Township. A copy of said Automatic Renewal COA is on file at the OCTV&T.
- On or about September 6, 2018, following discussions and agreement between Comcast and Upper Deerfield, the Township adopted Ordinance 782 (the "2018 Ordinance"), modifying the 1994 Ordinance Associated as Exhibit A.

 The 2018 Ordinance CE 09030208 ogether, are hereinafter referred to as the "Ordinance".
- 11. The 201

 24 Ordinance by deleting a requirement that Comcast's local business onice be located only in the Township or the Township of Bridgeton and substituting a provision allowing the office to be located in the Union Crossing Development in Millville, New Jersey, if not in the Township or the Township of Bridgeton.
- 12. By letter dated October 1, 2018, a copy of which is annexed hereto as Exhibit B, Comcast formally accepted the terms of the Ordinance.
- 13. Accordingly, Comcast hereby requests that the Board approve the modification of the 1994 Ordinance as set forth under the 2018 Ordinance.

WHEREFORE, it is respectfully requested that this Honorable Board of Public Utilities approve of the modification of the terms and conditions of the underlying municipal consent ordinance upon which the Automatic Renewal COA is based, as set forth more particularly in the Ordinance.

TOWNSHIP OF UPPER DEERFIELD

ORDINANCE 782

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10 OF ORDINANCE NO. 424 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER DEERFIELD, COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, on July 7, 1994 the Township of Upper Deerfield adopted Ordinance No. 424, granting non-exclusive municipal consent to the renewal of the cable television franchise of Sammons Communications of New Jersey, Inc. to construct, operate, extend, and maintain a cable television system in the Township of Upper Deerfield (the "Franchise"), which Franchise is currently operating subject to a Renewal Certificate of Approval issued on November 30, 2011 by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities under Docket No. CE09030208; and

WHEREAS, through a series of corporate transfers and name changes, on or about May 13, 2004, Comcast of South Jersey, LLC ("Comcast" or "Company"), became the holder of the Franchise; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield wishes to modify Section 10 of Ordinance No. 424;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that Section 10 of Ordinance No. 424, entitled "Local Office", shall be deleted and replaced as follows:

10. Local Office.

During the term of this franchise, and any renewal thereof, Upper Deerfield Township accepts the location of a local business office in the Union Crossing Development in Millville NJ on Highway 47, if a site is not located in the City of Bridgeton or the Township of Upper Deerfield, for the purpose of receiving, investigating and resolving all complaints regarding the quality of service, equipment malfunctions and similar matters. The local office as approved herein shall not be changed without amendment to Ordinance No. 424, subject to BPU approval.

All other provisions of Ordinance No. 424 shall remain in force.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
