The above-captioned matter is a request by Public Service Electric and Gas Company (“PSE&G”) for approval of a five-year, \$7.3 billion program designed to implement an Advanced Metering Infrastructure (“AMI”) program within the PSE&G service territory. The AMI program will allow greater visibility of PSE&G’s distribution system which will allow its operators to see the status of down networks, including customers without power. This program will help with restoration improvements, which will increase restoration of service and lead to customer satisfaction.

5. OSI's participant status will not cause any undue delay or confusion with regarding to these proceedings.


