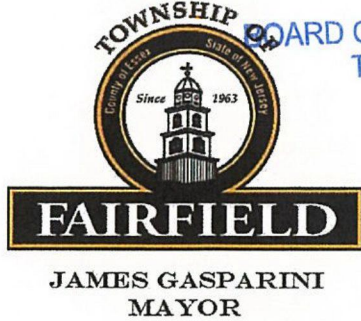

- improves PSE&G's already strong customer service.


