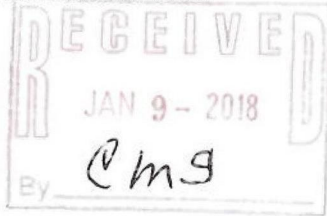

VERIFIED PETITION

DOCKET NO.

Comcast of South Jersey, LLC (“Comcast” or “Petitioner”) hereby petitions the Honorable Board of Public Utilities (the “Board”), pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1 et seq., and N.J.A.C. 14:17-6.7, for modification of the terms and conditions of a municipal consent upon which a Certificate of Approval is based. This Petition is engendered by the modification by the City of Vineland (“City”) of Ordinance No. 2008-80, authorizing Comcast to provide service in and to the City, as set forth more fully herein. In support of the within Petition, Petitioner states as follows:

COUNT ONE

1. Comcast, a limited liability company duly organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, is a cable television company subject to the jurisdiction of the Office of Cable Television & Telecommunications (“OCTV&T”) and the Board, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1 et seq.

2. Comcast maintains its principal offices at 1250 Haddonfield-Berlin Road, Cherry Hill, NJ 08034.

3. On or about February 25, 2009, in Docket No. CE09010029, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-17(a) and (b), and N.J.S.A. 48:5A-28(c), the Board issued a Renewal Certificate of Approval (“Renewal COA”) to Petitioner, to continue to construct, operate and maintain a cable television system in the City of Vineland (“City” or “Vineland”). A copy of said Renewal COA is on file at the OCTV&T.

4. The Renewal COA granted in Docket No. CE09010029 was premised upon underlying municipal consent ordinance 2008-80, adopted by the City on November 25, 2008 (the “2008 Ordinance”). A copy of the 2008 Ordinance is on file at the OCTV&T. The renewal period granted to Petitioner under the 2008 Ordinance, as set forth in the Renewal COA, was fifteen (15) years, with an automatic renewal period thereafter of ten (10) years. Thus, as stated in the Renewal COA, the expiration date of the initial term is September 10, 2022.

5. On or about October 24, 2017, the City adopted Ordinance No. 2017-70 (the “2017 Ordinance”), modifying the 2008 Ordinance. A copy of the 2017 Ordinance is annexed hereto as Exhibit A. The 2017 Ordinance and the 2008 Ordinance, together, are hereinafter referred to as the “Ordinance”.

6. The 2017 Ordinance modifies Section 16 of the 2008 Ordinance with respect to the organization and operation of a cable television advisory committee.

7. By letter dated November 1, 2017, a copy of which is annexed hereto as Exhibit B, Comcast formally accepted the terms of the Ordinance.

8. Accordingly, Comcast hereby requests that the Board approve the modification of the 2008 Ordinance as set forth under the 2017 Ordinance with respect to the organization and operation of a City cable television advisory committee.

WHEREFORE, it is respectfully requested that this Honorable Board of Public Utilities approve of the modification of the terms and conditions of the underlying municipal consent ordinance upon which the Renewal COA is based, as set forth more particularly in the Ordinance.



ORDINANCE NO. 2017 - 70

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2008-80 ESTABLISHING THE CABLE TELEVISION FRANCHISE PRESENTLY KNOWN AS CHAPTER A730 OF THE VINELAND CITY CODE.

WHEREAS, on November 25, 2008, City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2008-80 entitled "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING RENEWAL OF MUNICIPAL CONSENT TO COMCAST OF SOUTH JERSEY L.L.C. TO CONSTRUCT, CONNECT, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN A CABLE TELEVISION AND COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM IN VINELAND.", presently known as Chapter A730 of the Vinland City Code; and

WHEREAS, it is considered in the best interest of the City of Vinland to amend said ordinance to make the cable advisory committee optional rather than mandatory.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Vinland that Ordinance No. 2008-80 entitled "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING RENEWAL OF MUNICIPAL CONSENT TO COMCAST OF SOUTH JERSEY L.L.C. TO CONSTRUCT, CONNECT, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN A CABLE TELEVISION AND COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM IN VINELAND.", presently known as Chapter A730, Cable Television Franchise of the Vinland City Code, be and the same, is hereby amended as follows:

Revise §A730-16 to read:

§A730-16. Advisory committee.

The Council of the City of Vinland may, in its discretion, appoint an advisory committee (herein, the "committee"), consisting of five (5) members, one (1) member to be appointed by each Council person. The committee may also appoint one (1) alternate member. The committee shall meet periodically at Vinland City Hall, unless the committee unanimously agrees to meet elsewhere, and shall:

1. Monitor compliance of the city and the company with regard to the conditions of the franchise.
2. Discuss and recommend solutions to problems concerning the operation of the cable system.
3. Attempt to resolve any problems which may result from implementation of this ordinance.
4. Recommend to the city, on a timely basis, any changes in this franchise which in the future could be permitted under federal or state law changes, amendments and judicial interpretations hereafter promulgated. Such changes are subject to the formal amendment process, which shall include acceptance from the company and approval from the Board of Regulatory Commissioners pursuant to existing law.
5. Develop rules for the use the EG channel and provide the company with a copy of said rules.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any ordinance or provision thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect upon publication and passage in the manner provided by law.




