Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("PSE&G") hereby moves for an Order granting it status as an Intervenor (with all the rights of a full party) in the above-referenced matter, pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 1:1-16.1 *et seq*. In support of this Motion, PSE&G respectfully submits:

- 1. PSE&G is a New Jersey public utility as defined by N.J.S.A. 48:2-13.
- 2. PSE&G is engaged as a New Jersey public utility in the purchase, distribution, and sale of natural gas for more than 1.8 million customers located within the State of New Jersey. PSE&G is also engaged in the purchase, transmission, distribution, and sale of electric energy and related utility services to more than 2.1 million residential, commercial, and industrial customers located within the State of New Jersey.

Soundview Paper Company, LLC ("Soundview" or "Petitioner) has filed the subject Petition seeking a determination from the Board that it qualifies, on a temporary and limited basis, for a reduction of at least 90% of the Societal Benefits Charge ("SBC") associated with the electric and natural gas distribution service to its Marcal Mill in Elmwood Park, New Jersey. PSE&G provides electric and natural gas service to the Marcal Mill.
- 6. Petitioner specifically references PSE&G's interest in the outcome of this matter, alleging: "Rather than Soundview paying 0% of its load-based allocation of SBC costs, PSE&G's customers would prefer that Soundview pay a reduced rate for the next two and a half years and then pay the full SBC rate thereafter." (Petition, ¶38)
- 7. Petitioner also alleges in its Petition that it "has a limited amount of time to make a final decision on the Marcal Mill and determine whether permanently restarting operations in New Jersey is economically viable." (Petition, ¶55). Soundview is a large customer of PSE&G, and therefore its economic viability is of significant interest to PSE&G.
- 8. The service territories, customers, and the operations of PSE&G are distinct from others parties and participants in this case. Thus, no other party or participant will represent the interests of PSE&G in this case.

- 9. PSE&G has a history of coordinating its activities in dockets at the Board with other parties where appropriate. PSE&G will coordinate its representation with other similarly situated parties or participants in this docket to the extent it finds such action appropriate.
- 10. Due to PSE&G's experience in the gas and electric industry, and the fact that it provides gas and electric service to the Marcal Mill, its intervention in this proceeding is likely to add constructively to the proceeding.
- 11. Precedent exists for PSE&G being granted intervention status in a matter such as the instant filing. For example, in BPU Docket No. EW17030256, Gerdau Ameristeel Sayreville, Inc. ("Gerdau") filed a petition with the Board of Public Utilities ("BPU") seeking a waiver of certain SBC requirements. Jersey Central Power and Light, as Gerdau's applicable electric service provider, and PSE&G as Gerdau's applicable gas service provider, both sought and were granted intervention status in that filing. *See* BPU Order dated May 31, 2017. In BPU Docket No. ER18070706, Soundview sought a 50% reduction in its electric SBC obligations. The Board granted PSE&G intervenor status in that proceeding.
 - 12. PSE&G will abide by the schedule set for this proceeding.
- 13. Soundview filed the Petition with the BPU on or about July 12, 2019; thus, PSE&G submits this intervention application in a timely manner that will not cause undue delay or confusion.

WHEREFORE, PSE&G respectfully requests an Order: (1) granting it rights as a full party Intervenor in this matter pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 1:1-16.1 *et seq.*, and (2) providing such further relief in connection therewith as is deemed reasonable, just, and consistent with the foregoing.
