Comcast of Gloucester County, LLC ("Comcast" or "Petitioner") hereby petitions the Honorable Board of Public Utilities (the "Board"), pursuant to 47 <u>U.S.C.</u> §546(c), <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 48:5A-15, 16, and 17, <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 14:17-6.9 and <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 14:18-13.1 <u>et seq.</u>, for a renewal of a Certificate of Approval to continue to construct, operate and maintain its cable television system ("System") in the Borough of Wenonah, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey ("Wenonah" or "Borough"). In support of its Petition, Petitioner states as follows:

COUNT ONE

1. Comcast, a limited liability company duly organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, is a cable television company subject to the jurisdiction of the Office of Cable Television & Telecommunications ("OCTV&T") and the Board, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1 et seq.

- Comcast maintains its principal offices at 1250 Haddonfield-Berlin Road, Cherry Hill, New Jersey 08034.
- 3. On or about January 9, 1980, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-17(a) and (b), and 28(c), the Board issued a Certificate of Approval to Gloucester County CATV Associates ("Gloucester Cable") to construct, operate and maintain the System in the Borough in Docket No. 7910C-6566. A copy of said Certificate of Approval is on file at the OCTV&T.
- 4. Pursuant to authorization granted by the Board in its Order of Approval dated May 29, 1980 in Docket No. 805C-6680, the System owned and operated by Gloucester Cable, including the Certificate of Approval pertaining to the Borough, was transferred to Comcast (previously known as Storer Cable Communications of Gloucester County, Inc.). A copy of said Order is on file at the OCTV&T.
- 5. On or about September 24, 1990, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-17(a) and (b), and 28(c), the Board issued a Renewal Certificate of Approval to Comcast in Docket No. CE89090804 to construct, operate and maintain the System in the Borough. A copy of said Renewal Certificate of Approval is on file at the OCTV&T.
- 6. On or about September 15, 2000, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-17(a) and (b), and 28(c), the Board issued a Renewal Certificate of Approval to Comcast in Docket No. CE00050315 to construct, operate and maintain the System in the Borough. A copy of said Renewal Certificate of Approval is on file at the OCTV&T.
- 7. On or about March 25, 2010, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-17(a) and (b), and 28(c), the Board issued a Renewal Certificate of Approval to Comcast in Docket No. CE09110901 to construct, operate and maintain the System in the Borough ("2010 Renewal Certificate of Approval"). A copy of said 2010 Renewal Certificate of Approval is on file at the OCTV&T.

- 8. The 2010 Renewal Certificate of Approval, in accordance with its underlying municipal consent ordinance, reflected and included an automatic renewal provision, pursuant to which the Borough of Wenonah's franchise would be subject to automatic renewal for a period of ten (10) years following its scheduled expiration date January 9, 2020.
- 9. As set forth under N.J.A.C. 14:18-13.6, applicable to ordinances which provide for automatic renewal, in the absence of notice at least 60 days prior to expiration of the initial term of a franchise from either the cable television company or the municipality of its intention to not renew, a franchise will be deemed to automatically renew.
- 10. Neither the Borough nor Comcast provided notice of its intention to not renew the Wenonah franchise pursuant to N.J.A.C. 14:18-13.6 prior to the deadline set forth therein for such action, as confirmed in Comcast's letter to the Borough dated December 9, 2019, a copy of which is annexed hereto as Exhibit A. As set forth therein, Comcast further confirmed its intention to exercise its rights under the automatic renewal provision of the 2010 Renewal Certificate of Approval.
- 11. As a result of the foregoing, Comcast's franchise in Wenonah shall be deemed to automatically renew.
- 12. Accordingly, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 14:18-13.6, Comcast hereby requests approval and implementation of the automatic renewal provision of the 2010 Renewal Certificate of Approval granted in Docket No. CE09110901, to continue to construct, operate and maintain the System in the Borough.
- 13. The information pertaining to Petitioner on file with the OCTV&T, together with the information contained in Petitioner's Application for Automatic Renewal of a Certificate of Approval ("COA Application") pertaining to the Borough, simultaneously filed herewith, all of

which is adopted by reference thereto, establishes the requisite criteria for the continued construction, operation and maintenance of the System in Wenonah by Comcast.

- 14. Comcast possesses the requisite character and suitability for the continued operation of the System. Further, as indicated in the material filed with the Borough and on file with the OCTV&T, Comcast possesses the necessary financial integrity and the ability to perform efficiently the proposed services and those services which may be required by the public convenience and necessity during the renewal period. The public convenience and necessity generally support the appropriateness of the issuance of a Renewal Certificate of Approval to Petitioner.
- 15. Comcast has complied, and will continue to comply, with all rules, regulations and laws applicable to the construction, operation and maintenance of the System and will continue to provide safe, adequate and proper cable television service in Wenonah and the other municipalities in which it serves.

COUNT TWO

- 16. Comcast repeats paragraphs 1 through 15 of COUNT ONE as if set forth fully hereinafter.
- 17. As set forth in the COA Application, the System operated by Comcast in the Borough is part of larger regional cable television systems serving numerous other municipalities contiguous to and surrounding the Borough.
- 18. As also set forth in the COA Application, the Borough represents an integral part of the Comcast regional cable television system serving the Counties of Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester and Salem. In addition, the demographics of the Borough, as well as its location and other factors, mandate that cable television service be

provided by Comcast as part of Comcast's regional systems.

- 19. The Borough portion of Comcast's Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester and Salem County cable systems is necessary for the continued provision of safe, adequate and economical cable television service to the citizens and residents of the Borough and the larger cable television systems generally. Further, a continuation of Comcast's operating authority in the Borough will avoid an unreasonable duplication of services which would otherwise be detrimental to the development of adequate cable television service.
- 20. Comcast is entitled to a renewal of its Certificate of Approval for the Borough pursuant to the provisions of Section 17(b) of the New Jersey Cable Television Act, N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1 et seq.
- 21. Comcast believes that a Renewal Certificate of Approval for the Borough is necessary and proper for the public convenience and will serve the public interest for reasons which include, <u>inter alia</u>, the following:
- a. The grant of a Renewal Certificate of Approval to Comcast will ensure the continued provision of cable television service to the residents of the Borough;
- b. The services provided by Comcast in its COA Application are of great benefit to the citizens and residents of the Borough;
- c. The financial strength and technical expertise of Comcast are more than adequate to continue to construct, operate and maintain its cable television system in the Borough; and
- d. Comcast, its officers and directors, have vast experience in all aspects of cable television. In particular, they possess and represent the highest degree of technical and engineering competence, significant administrative experience and a demonstrated

responsiveness to community needs. In addition to the Borough, Comcast and its affiliates hold

Certificates of Approval or other authorization to construct, operate and maintain cable television

systems in more than 340 municipalities in New Jersey, as well as additional communities in 38

other states.

WHEREFORE, it is requested that this Honorable Board of Public Utilities issue to

Comcast of Gloucester County, LLC a Renewal Certificate of Approval to continue to construct,

operate and maintain a cable television system in the Borough of Wenonah.
