Zero Emission Certificate Charge**

In accordance with P.L. 1997, c. 162, all charges for electricity supplied are subject to the New Jersey Sales and Use Tax ("SUT") as computed by multiplying the charges that would apply before application of the SUT by **0.06625**

The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities issued a Zero Emission Certificate (ZEC) Charge Order in connection with BPU Docket No. E018080899 and E018091018 authorizing implementation of a non-bypassable, irrevocable charge of .004 dollars per KWH. The ZEC charge reflects the emission avoidance benefits of the continued operation of selected nuclear plants.

The ZEC Charge shall be applied to the KWH usage on the bills of all customers outside of the Borough of Butler served under this schedule.
