Dear Secretary Camacho-Welch:

Please accept for filing this letter on behalf of PSEG Nuclear ("PSEG" or "the PSEG applicants") in connection with the above-referenced Zero Emissions Certificate ("ZEC") proceeding. PSEG is the sole owner and operator of the Hope Creek plant. PSEG is also the operator and majority co-owner of the Salem 1 and Salem 2 plants along with Exelon Generation Company, LLC ("Exelon Generation") as co-owner of the minority interests. Pursuant to the Board of Public Utilities' August 12, 2020 Order Establishing the Application Process for the Second Eligibility Period and Approving Request for Quotation, applicants in the ZEC proceeding must file notices of intent to file by August 19, 2020. PSEG hereby submits this letter as its notice

of intent to file applications in the ZEC proceeding with respect to its three nuclear generation units: (1) Salem 1; (2) Salem 2; and (3) Hope Creek.

PSEG expects to submit the applications for the Salem units on behalf of both PSEG and Exelon Generation. Exelon Generation will submit separately supplemental information that cannot be shared with PSEG.
