The COMPANY'S RATE PROPOSAL

The changes set forth in the Company's Petition were proposed to become effective for service rendered on or after April 13, 2020, or at such later date as the Board may determine. Pursuant to an Order issued April 6, 2020, the Board suspended the proposed changes until August 13, 2020. By a subsequent Order issued July 15, 2020, the Board forther suspended the proposed changes until December 13, 2020, unless prior to that date the Board makes a determination disposing of the Petition or enters an Order further suspending the proposed changes. Based on the Company's total projected operating revenues for the 12 months ending June 30, 2020, the new rates proposed herein would yield additional operating revenues of approximately \$75.7 million or 13.1% (after giving effect to: (1) the roll-in of the Company's Conservation Incentive Program ("CIP") revenues; and (2) the roll-ins to base rates for the Campany's Storm Hardening and Reliability Pragram ("SHARP II") and Accelerated Infrastructure Replacement Program ("AIRP II") to take place on October 1, 2020, austide of this base rate case).

The typical commercial customer using 500 therms of gas per month would receive a decrease of \$11.25 or 1.8%. Moreover, any rate relief found by the Board to be just and reasonable may be allocated by the Board and applied by the Company to any class or classes of customers or any rate schedule or rate schedules as the Board may determine so that final rates approved by the Board in this proceeding for any specific customer class or rate schedule may be higher or lower than those set forth herein.
