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NOTICE OF WORK SESSION¹

Investigation of Resource Adequacy Alternatives

Docket No. EO20030203

Pursuant to the "Open Public Meetings Act," N.J.S.A. 10:4-6, et seq., the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("NJBPU" or "Board") hereby gives notice of a third Work Session in the Board's ongoing [Investigation of Resource Adequacy Alternatives](#) designed to examine how New Jersey can best achieve its long-term clean energy and environmental objectives under the current resource adequacy paradigm.

This third Work Session will allow stakeholders to review the results of the financial modeling performed of different proposed alternatives, and provide additional feedback. Staff anticipates exploring the cost of the expanded Minimum Offer Price Rule (MOPR), as well as the outcomes of other options under consideration. To facilitate the third Work Session, NJBPU's consultant, The Brattle Group, will present draft financial modeling results illustrating the likely costs and benefits of different options.

The third Work Session will be conducted virtually on **March 19, 2021 at 1 p.m. ET.**

At the conclusion of the third Work Session, NJBPU Staff anticipates releasing a report discussing the findings of the Investigation. Similar to the format of the three work sessions, the report will evaluate Fixed Resource Requirement (FRR) options, the Integrated Clean Capacity Market (ICCM) and the financial implications of these options in context of the expanded MOPR.


