I helped put together Aqua's first Sustainability Report to shareholders. I retired from Aqua in 2013.


I am also an officer on the board of the Water Resources Association fo the Delaware River Basin and a member of the board of the Drexel University Institute for Energy and the Environment.

Seeing the impacts (extreme weather, sea level rise and others) of climate change on New Jersey and around the world, I am convinced that good energy policy is critical to tackling the existential threat we face locally and worldwide from exploitation of fossil fuels and carbon emissions.

PSEG Nuclear provides about 40% of the electricity generated in New Jersey, and 90% of the carbon-free power at a fraction of the cost to ratepayers of renewable power generation.

The NJ BPU can do its part by renewing the ZECs for PSEG Nuclear.
