Notice of Transfer of Funds

Dear Secretary Camacho-Welch:

Please allow this letter to serve as notice of transfer of funds between the Energy Strong II Electric subprograms in accordance with the terms of the Energy Strong II Program (the "ES II" or the "Program") and associated stipulation approved by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (the "Board") by Order dated September 11, 2019 in Docket Nos. EO18060629 and GO18060630.

Paragraph 22 of the Program Stipulation provides flexibility in the administration of the ES II subprograms by allowing for the immediate transfers of funds within the electric sub-programs where the cumulative amount of the transfer is five percent (5%) or less of the overall ES II electric program investment. In the event of such a transfer, Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("PSE&G" or the "Company") shall notify Board Staff and Rate Counsel of the changes within 30 days following the change.

In accordance with the above-referenced provision, the Company hereby provides notice of its transfer of \$7.7M from the Grid Modernization, Communication System subprogram to the Grid Modernization, Advanced Distribution Management System ("ADMS") subprogram. The total cumulative amount of \$7.7M that PSE&G is moving pursuant to this notice is less than 5% of the Energy Strong total electric program investment of \$741 million. Under the terms of the ES II Order, no further action by the Board or filing by any party is anticipated or required in order for PSE&G to proceed.

Consistent with the Order issued by the Board in connection with *In the Matter of the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities' Response to the COVID-19 Pandemic for a Temporary Waiver of Requirements for Certain Non-Essential Obligations*, BPU Docket No. EO20030254, Order dated March 19, 2020, this document is being filed electronically with the Secretary of the Board and Rate Counsel. No paper copies will follow.
