
Dear Secretary Camacho-Welch:

Logan Generating Company, L.P. (“Logan”) submits this correspondence in support of Atlantic City Electric Company’s (“ACE”) request for approval of the Settlement Agreement between ACE and Logan pursuant to which ACE would modify the existing Power Purchase Agreement and terminate the existing Power Sales Agreement with Logan.

Logan believes the Settlement Agreement represents a good outcome for all parties concerned, including ACE’s approximately 560,000 residential, commercial, and industrial customers. If approved, those customers would benefit from lower rates for their electricity. Further, the citizens of New Jersey, in general, would benefit from Logan permanently ceasing the combustion of any coal at its facility. The record presented in this proceeding supports the Board’s approval of the Settlement Agreements in the public interest.

Logan also notes that ACE has sought expedited review and approval of the Settlement Agreement, particularly seeking action by the Board’s March 23, 2022 public meeting. Logan believes that expeditious approval of the Settlement Agreement, as presented with ACE’s petition in this docket, is also in the public interest and would provide numerous economic and other benefits for ACE’s customers and the citizens of New Jersey. Thus, Logan urges the Board to grant the relief sought by ACE in the above captioned proceeding on an expedited schedule.
