Dear Secretary Camacho-Welch:

Pursuant to the Board's March 7, 2022 Notice ("Notice"), NextEra Energy Transmission MidAtlantic Holdings, LLC ("NEETMA") hereby submits the following: (1) all public and confidential versions of NEETMA Applications and any subsequent information and materials that have been submitted to PJM; (2) a public and confidential version of NEETMA's Supplemental Information; and (3) the Affidavit of Johnbinh Vu supporting the confidential treatment of NEETMA's Privileged, Confidential, and Commercial, and Trade Secret Information and Critical Electric Infrastructure Information in its Applications and Supplemental Information.

As NEETMA presented on March 22, 2022, NEETMA's New Jersey Seawind Connector proposals will enable New Jersey to meet or exceed its offshore wind goal of 7,500 megawatts by 2035. NEETMA's proposal brings experience, financial strength, certainty of project delivery, flexibility in project design, a project design that minimizes environmental and marine impacts, and strong cost commitments that reduce the cost and risk to ratepayers.
