On February 2, 2022, Ocean Wind, LLC ("Ocean Wind"), filed a Verified Petition with the Board under BPU Docket No. QO22020041, together with supporting testimony and exhibits. The Verified Petition seeks the Board's determination that certain easements across property owned by the City of Ocean City ("Ocean City"), which are designated as Green Acres restricted properties, are reasonably necessary for the construction or operation of the Ocean Wind 1 Qualified Offshore Wind Project ("Project"). The property at issue is identified on the Official Tax Map of Ocean City as Block 611.11, Lots 137 and 145, Block 3500, Lot 1 (including riparian grant) and Block 3350.01, Lot 17 owned in fee by Ocean City. The Verified Petition also seeks the Board's determination that certain municipal consents and approvals are preempted and superseded, upon the Board finding them reasonably necessary for the construction and operation of the Project.

The easements and related approvals sought in the Verified Petition concern a segment of the onshore cable route that is proposed to be constructed in Ocean City. The onshore cable route will help transmit power from Ocean Wind's 1,100 MW offshore wind farm to load centers in the state.

A copy of this Notice of Public Hearing on the Verified Petition is being served upon the Clerk and governing body of the City of Ocean City, the Clerk and Administrator of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Cape May, the Cape May County Clerk, the Department of Law & Public Safety, New Jersey Division of Law, the Director of the New Jersey Division of Rate Counsel, and the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection. This Notice is also being provided to the local news media. The Board has the statutory authority pursuant N.J.S.A. 48:3-87.1(f) to determine whether the requested easements are reasonably necessary for the construction or operation of the Project, and if such a determination is made, the Board shall issue an order approving the acquisition of the requested easements and related approvals. The Board intends to review and consider input from the public in making their determination.

Representatives from Ocean Wind will be asked to present an overview of the project at both sessions. Board Staff and the New Jersey Division of Rate Counsel will participate in both sessions. Members of the public are invited to virtually attend and present their views on this matter by registering through the above links.
