On April 29, 2022, NextEra Energy Transmission MidAtlantic Holdings, LLC (“NEETMA”) filed comments with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“BPU”) in response to BPU’s March 4, 2022 notice requesting “additional information to inform the Board’s evaluation of offshore wind transmission proposals submitted to PJM Interconnection, LLC pursuant to the PJM State Agreement Approach.” Based upon additional review, NEETMA believes additional information in the April 29 comments may be unredacted.
