Dear Acting Secretary Diaz:

By Order dated March 23, 2022, the Board of Public Utilities (“Board”) approved Settlement Agreements and Modified PPAs between Atlantic City Electric Company (“ACE” or “the Company”) and Chambers Cogeneration Limited Partnership (“Chambers”) and Logan Generation Company Limited Partnership (“Logan”). In approving the Settlement Agreements and Modified PPAs, the Board found the proposed payments to be “just and reasonable.” The Board further found that the Settlement Agreements will result in a substantial reduction to the Company’s stranded costs. With its approval, the Board directed ACE to submit certain notices.

In April, ACE provided the first such notice, which was a notice of the closing and final payment schedule. The Final Decision and Order issued by the Board on March 23, 2022 also directed the Company to provide notice on the following items 2, 3 & 4. For ease of reference, the Company restates those notice requirements below.

2. *Within 15 days of the cessation of coal-fired electric generation at Chambers, ACE shall provide notification to the Board and Rate Counsel that coal-fired generation has ceased at Chambers.*

3. *Within 15 days of the cessation of coal-fired electric generation at Logan, ACE shall provide notification to the Board and Rate Counsel that coal-fired generation has ceased at Logan.*

Please accept this correspondence as the required notice informing the Board and Rate Counsel that as of **June 7, 2022, at 15:01**, the Chambers Cogeneration LP, coal fire generating plant located at 500 Shell Road, Carneys Point, NJ has been deactivated and retired from service. Please accept this correspondence as further notice that as of **May 31, 2022, at 15:18**, the Logan Generating Company, L.P, coal fired generating plant located at 76 US-130, Swedesboro, NJ has also been deactivated and retired from service. Accordingly, coal fired generation at both units has ceased.

4. *Within 30 days of the commencement of the production of steam using natural gas fired boilers with fuel oil back-up at Chambers, ACE shall provide notification of this commencement to the Board and Rate Counsel.*

Please accept this correspondence as the required notice informing the Board and Rate Counsel that as of June 7, 2022, at 15:01, with the closure of the coal fired generation, Chambers has converted their operation to natural gas fired boilers for steam production for Chemours, with No. 2 fuel oil back up.

ACE respectfully submits this correspondence as the remaining notice contemplated in the Final Decision and Order issued by the Board on March 23, 2022. This correspondence is being electronically filed with the Board and Rate Counsel. No paper copies will follow.
