Consistent with the March 19, 2020 Order of the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (the “Board”) in I/M/O the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities’ Response to the COVID-19 Pandemic for a Temporary Waiver of Requirements for Certain Non-Essential Obligations, BPU Docket No. EO20030254, this communication is being filed electronically with the Secretary of the Board and is being provided to each person on the service list by electronic mail only. In this proceeding, Atlantic City Electric Company (“ACE”) is seeking Board approval of its proposed Rider RNM – Remote Net Energy Metering tariff. On March 16, 2022, following discussions among the parties, ACE submitted a revised version of the proposed tariff. Rate Counsel has not objection to the Board’s approval of the tariff as reflected in ACE’s March 16, 2022 filing, provided the next-to-last sentence of the third paragraph of the proposed tariff provision is amended to read as follows:

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The Company, contingent on the cooperation of the Public Entity Applicant(s), will continue to perform any additional technical processing of the eligible public entities' interconnection application, subject to the Board's final approval or denial.

The underlined text reflects Rate Counsel's proposed addition to the language as proposed in ACE's March 16, 2022 filing. With this amendment, the tariff provision will more accurately reflect the consensus reached by the parties.
