The New Jersey State League of Municipalities (the "League") hereby moves for an order of the Board of Public Utilities ("Board") granting leave to participate in the within mater in accordance with the Order of the Board of June 29, 2022, as modified July 14, 2022, and pursuant to N.J.A.C. 1:1-16.6, which provides that any person or entity with a significant interest in the outcome of a case may move for permission to participate. For the reasons set forth below, the League respectfully requests the Board to (1) grant it full rights to participate in this matter pursuant to N.J.A.C. 1:1-16.6, and (2) order such further relief in connection therewith as the Board deems reasonable and just.

In support of this motion, the League states:

- Operating since 1915, the New Jersey State League of Municipalities is non-partisan, voluntary non-profit association created to assist New Jersey's local governments by acting as a repository for knowledge and expertise.
- 2. The League acts as an advocate for New Jersey's municipalities before the State and federal government, protecting communities' rights to self-government, and the promotion of strong local government.
- 3. Ocean Wind has publicly announced that it plans to install upwards of 200 wind turbines on towers as far as 900' or more off the shore of Cape May County for the generation of electricity.
- 4. Ocean Wind's current Petition adverse to the County of Cape May seeks to gain Board approval of a route for transmission cable to deliver wind-generated electricity ultimately to the electrical grid.
- 5. Ocean Wind has submitted a Petition to be considered by the Board under N.J.S.A. 48:3-87.1(f), the second such petition to be considered by the Board under this new law.
- 6. Each decision made by the Board in interpreting and applying N.J.S.A. 48:3-87.1(f) will impact New Jersey's municipal governments and their land use activities, as those decisions will serve to act as precedent should such a Petition be filed in connection with a Qualified Offshore Wind Project in the future.
- 7. The decision of the Board, along with the procedural processes adopted in considering Petitions under N.J.S.A. 48:3-87.1(f) will have a lasting effect on all municipalities.
- 8. The League, as a statewide advocate for municipal government, has an obligation to ensure that the interests of our members are represented in this process.

- Allowing the League to participate in this matter will add judicial economy and provide the Board with additional perspective on more general municipal concerns.
- 10. The League will work with the parties to establish a procedural schedule in this case.
- 11. The Verification of League Executive Director, Michael F. Cerra is attached hereto stating the facts stated in this motion are true and accurate to the best of his knowledge and belief.
