- Petitioner files pre-filed testimony - September 20
- All parties submit initial list of intended witnesses – September 20\*\*
- Discovery on Petitioner testimony - September 29
- Petitioner responds to discovery - October 5
- Rate Counsel/Intervenors file testimony - October 19
- Discovery on Rate Counsel/Intervenor testimony - October 26
- Responses to discovery - November 4
- Rebuttal testimony filed - November 21
- Discovery on Rebuttal testimony - November 28
- Discovery on Rebuttal testimony answered - December 6


\*\*This list will not preclude any party from adding additional witnesses as necessary throughout the proceeding unless otherwise ordered by the Court.
