### **IN THE MATTER OF THE NEW JERSEY INVESTIGATIONS INTO RESOURCE ADEQUACY: 2022 PROGRESS REPORT**

The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“BPU” or “Board”) hereby gives notice of a virtual stakeholder meeting to discuss the 2022 Progress Report on New Jersey’s Resource Adequacy Alternatives (“2022 Staff Report”).

The 2022 Staff Report follows up on the Board’s Investigation of Resource Adequacy Alternatives proceeding (Docket No. EO20030203), which directed Staff to provide recommendations on how New Jersey should seek to reform the wholesale electricity markets and align them with the State’s clean energy targets in a manner that cost-effectively ensures system reliability. The 2022 Staff Report summarizes the options evaluated in the Investigation of Resource Adequacy Alternatives docket, discusses progress made to date on reforming the wholesale markets to better accommodate the State’s clean energy policies, and provides Staff’s recommendation on which options, if any, should be pursued. 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
