# MOTION TO INTERVENE OF MARCAL MANUFACTURING, LLC

Marcal Manufacturing, LLC ("Marcal") hereby moves for an Order granting it status as an Intervenor in the above-referenced matter pursuant to N.J.A.C. 1:1-16.1 – 16.4. In support of this Motion, Marcal respectfully submits:

- 1. This proceeding involves a request by Public Service Electric & Gas Company ("PSE&G") for a Service Agreement Extension between PSE&G and Marcal for natural gas distribution service provided to Marcal's facilities located at 1 Market Street, Elmwood Park, New Jersey. Pursuant to Rate Schedule Contract Gas Service ("CSG") in PSE&G's Boardapproved Tariff for Gas Service, PSE&G and Marcal request Board approval of the Service Agreement Extension for a period of three years, commencing on December 1, 2022.
- 2. Marcal's current CSG Agreement, which was approved by the Board in 2015 is set to expire on December 1, 2022. *See In the Matter of Rate Schedule CSG Transportation*Service Agreement Between Public Service Electric and Gas Company and Marcal

  Manufacturing, LLC and the Potential Discount of Societal Benefits Charges, Order Approving

  Stipulation, Docket No. GR15060659 (Nov. 16, 2015).
- 3. Earlier this year, Marcal submitted a request to PSE&G seeking a three-year extension of its current CSG Agreement pursuant to Other Considerations in Rate Schedule CSG

in PSE&G's Gas Service Tariff. PSE&G reviewed the information set forth in Marcal's CSG application, and after additional discussions and information exchanges, agreed that it is reasonable to extend Marcal's CSG rate for three years, starting on December 1, 2022. Given the upcoming expiration of the current CSG Agreement, PSE&G has requested expedited approval of the Service Agreement Extension.

- 4. As a party to the Service Agreement including in this proceeding, Marcal will be directly and specifically affected by the relief requested in PSE&G's Letter Petition, and has a substantial interest in the outcome of this proceeding. Board approval of the Service Agreement Extension will allow Marcal to control its energy costs, which will in turn allow Marcal to continue to operate, employ New Jersey residents, and contribute to the State's economy.
- 5. Further, because Marcal is at risk of the expiration of the current CSG Agreement, Marcal requests that the Board expedite its treatment of this matter and approve the Service Agreement Extension (or a temporary extension to the current CSG Agreement) at its earliest convenience.
- 6. Marcal's interests in this proceeding are unique and distinct, and no other party can adequately represent Marcal's interests in this matter.
  - 7. The granting of this Motion will not cause undue delay or confusion.

WHEREFORE, Marcal respectfully requests an Order (1) granting it rights as an intervenor in this matter pursuant to N.J.A.C. 1:1-16.1-16.5, thereby providing it all rights of a full party to this matter; (2) approving the CSG Service Agreement Extension at its earliest convenience (or a temporary extension in the current CSG rate); (3) and providing such further relief in connection therewith as is deemed reasonable, just, and consistent with the foregoing.
