For over 40 years, the Alliance has focused exclusively on promoting responsible infrastructure investment in New Jersey and the region including energy delivery and renewable energy, transportation, water, and coastal protection.

Thank you for allowing me to share the Alliance's perspective on the New Jersey Medium and Heavy-Duty Electric Vehicle Straw Proposal.

Let me summarize our organization's comments:

- We support allowing utilities to invest in infrastructure that will help speed the process of converting small commercial fleets to EV status. And to do it beyond the scope of what is presently proposed.
- Our utilities can also provide technical support for those participating in the National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) Program.

We believe making greater use of utility expertise as we have suggested above will better enable the state to meet its MHD EV goals of 30% of all vehicles by 2030. New Jersey needs to create a comprehensive EV Ecosystem that provides both light-duty and MHD EVs with public access to charging infrastructure on key travel corridors and at key workplaces.
