By Board Order dated April 27, 2021 (the “April 27, 2021 Order”) in the above referenced matter and docket, Atlantic City Electric Company (“ACE” or the “Company”) was directed, beginning in 2023, to combine its three-year Energy Efficiency (“EE”) Program annual reconciliation filing with the reconciliation filing(s) for its other RGGI components annual reconciliation filing(s). This direction is included in footnote 13 on page 13 of the April 27, 2021 Order. Also found on page 13 of the April 27, 2021 Order, in Paragraph 32, the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (the “Board” or “BPU”) directed ACE to file its annual EE Surcharge reconciliation true-up “no later than February 28, 2022 and annually thereafter.” The Board’s April 27, 2021 Order does not specify a particular date each successive year for the filing of the reconciliation of the EE Surcharge, except as noted below.


Footnote 13 (found on the same page of the April 27, 2021 Order) noted that, beginning in 2021, the Company had begun the process of filing annual reconciliations for its Solar Renewable Energy Certificate (“SREC”) I and SREC II programs, its Solar Transition Incentive (or TREC) program, and in 2022, its Successive Solar Incentive (or SuSI) program in a single consolidated reconciliation filing (referred to in this letter as the “Consolidated Rider RGGI Reconciliation Petition”). The April 27, 2021 Order directed that, beginning in 2023, the Company’s Consolidated Rider RGGI Reconciliation Petition include the Company’s EE Surcharge component. Since 2021, ACE has submitted its Consolidated Rider RGGI Reconciliation Petition in July of each year. Consistent with the Board’s direction, ACE intends to submit its next Consolidated Rider RGGI Reconciliation Petition, inclusive of the EE Surcharge component thereof, in July 2023.
