**VERIFIED PETITION
FOR A RENEWAL OF A
CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL**

CSC TKR, LLC d/b/a Cablevision of Morris, a limited liability company existing under the laws of the State of Delaware (hereinafter “Cablevision”) and a subsidiary of Altice USA, Inc., with its place of business at 1 Court Square West, Long Island City, NY 11101, hereby states in support of the within Petition:

1. Cablevision is a cable company as defined under the provisions of the New Jersey Cable Television Act., N.J.S.A. 48:5A-3(g), and is the current holder of a Certificate of Approval issued by this Honorable Board on December 18, 2008, for the construction, operation and maintenance of a cable system in the Township of Montville (hereinafter “Township”), County of Morris, State of New Jersey. The Certificate of Approval expired on December 18, 2018. A copy of the Certificate of Approval is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

2. Cablevision provided its Application for Municipal Consent to the Township pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-23. A copy of Cablevision's Application for a Cable Television Franchise was filed via separate email with this Board's Office of Cable Television.

3. On February 14, 2019, the Township adopted Municipal Ordinance No. 2019-02, renewing the consent of the Township for Cablevision to own, operate and maintain a cable system within the Township for a term of ten (10) years from the date of issuance of the Certificate of Approval requested herein. A copy of Ordinance No. 2019-02 is attached hereto as **Exhibit B**.

4. By letter dated May 3, 2019, Cablevision accepted the terms of the Township's Ordinance. A copy of said correspondence is attached hereto as **Exhibit C**.

5. A Petition for an Application for Renewal of a Certificate of Approval in this matter was originally filed with the Board on or about June 28, 2019.

6. By this filing herein, Cablevision supplements its Application for Renewal of a Certificate of Approval by addressing certain deficiencies identified by the Board's Office of Cable Television in a letter dated February 2, 2023. A copy of this corrected Application is being provided to the Clerk of the Township as required under N.J.A.C. § 14:18-12.1(2).

7. Cablevision maintains a local office for the use of its customers at 683 Route 10 East, Randolph, New Jersey 07869.

8. Cablevision has been operating its cable system within the Township in compliance with applicable federal and state law and in conformance with the rules, regulations and orders of the Board. Cablevision has fulfilled its material commitments set forth in the existing Certificate of Approval.

9. The granting of the within Petition for renewal of Cablevision's Certificate of Approval is necessary and proper for the public convenience and will serve the public interest as Cablevision has the financial, legal and technical ability to provide the proposed cable services during the term of the renewal.
