Dear Secretary Golden:

Elizabethtown Gas (“ETG”) would like to provide notice that ETG intends to modify incentive levels for programs available to residential customers within the ranges established by the joint utilities as specified on the enclosed Fact Sheet.

ETG is providing this notice in accordance with the established Staff Notification requirements for core program incentive adjustments, as detailed on page thirteen (13) of the Board’s June 10, 2020, Order Directing the Utilities to Establish Energy Efficiency and Peak Demand Reduction Programs (Docket Nos. QO19010040 & GO20090619).

ETG will offer these modified incentives to all customers eligible for and participating in the Energy Efficient Products program, effective as of July 1, 2023. The purpose of these incentive changes is to align with market conditions in our territory and in New Jersey. By increasing the incentives for these measures, we believe that this will increase program participation in an effort to achieve our triennium targets. A summary of the incentive changes can be found in the attached Fact Sheet.

Elizabethtown Gas – Energy Efficiency Program Modifications to Residential Incentives

Fact Sheet

The Elizabethtown Gas Efficient Products program will implement changes to certain incentives available to residential customers.

Eligibility:

All customers participating in the Efficient Products program who receive gas service from Elizabethtown Gas will receive these incentives.

These modified incentives will be available to all eligible Efficient Products program participants starting on the effective date of July 1, 2023.

Details:

Customer must participate in ETG's Energy Efficiency Program and follow all applicable Program rules.
