
MOTION FOR LEAVE TO APPEAL	DENIED

SUPPLEMENTAL:

The motion for leave to appeal is denied as petitioner has not demonstrated sufficient justification to overcome the strong policies disfavoring piecemeal review of litigation, Brundage v. Estate of Carambio, 195 N.J. 575, 599 (2008), a principle particularly applicable here as petitioner's motion for reconsideration of the Board's June 29, 2023 decision is currently pending before the Board. The matter is accordingly remanded to the Board of Public Utilities for resolution of the petitioner's motion for reconsideration. The stay imposed in our July 6, 2023 order is hereby vacated. Any request for a stay should be

filed, and addressed in the first instance, by the Board on remand. We do not retain jurisdiction.
