- 1. Cablevision is a cable company as defined under the provisions of the New Jersey Cable Television Act., N.J.S.A. 48:5A-3(g), and is the current holder of a Certificate of Approval issued by this Honorable Board on December 2, 2005, for the construction, operation and maintenance of a cable system in the Township of Berkeley (hereinafter "Municipality"), County of Ocean, State of New Jersey. The Certificate of Approval expired on December 1, 2020. A copy of the Certificate of Approval is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.
- 2. Cablevision provided its Application for Municipal Consent to the Municipality pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-23. A copy of Cablevision's Application for a Cable Television Franchise will be filed via separate email with this Board's Office of Cable Television.

3. On February 28, 2022, the Municipality adopted Municipal Ordinance No. 22-04-OA,

renewing the consent of the Municipality for Cablevision to own, operate and maintain a cable

system within the Municipality for a term of ten (10) years from the date of issuance of the Certificate

of Approval requested herein. A copy of Ordinance No. 22-04-OA is attached hereto as **Exhibit B**.

4. By letter dated May 16, 2022, Cablevision accepted the terms of the Municipality's

Ordinance. A copy of said correspondence is attached hereto as **Exhibit C**.

5. Cablevision maintains a local office for the use of its customers at 501 Boulevard

Seaside Heights, NJ 08751.

6. Cablevision has been operating its cable system within the Municipality in compliance

with applicable federal and state law and in conformance with the rules, regulations and orders of

the Board. Cablevision has fulfilled its material commitments set forth in the existing Certificate

of Approval.

7. The granting of the within Petition for renewal of Cablevision's Certificate of Approval

is necessary and proper for the public convenience and will serve the public interest as Cablevision

has the financial, legal and technical ability to provide the proposed cable services during the term

of the renewal.
