Rockland Electric Company ("RECO" or "the Company") hereby submits for filing with the Board of Public Utilities (the "Board") 29th Revised Leaf No. 56 to its Schedule for Electric Service, B.P.U. No. 3 – Electricity.

The tariff leaf is issued June 28, 2024, with an effective date of July 1, 2024, and is filed in compliance with the Board's *Order Approving Stipulation* (the "Order") dated June 27, 2024 in the above-referenced dockets. The Order directed the Company to file, prior to July 1, 2024, a revised tariff sheet reflecting the terms of the Order. Therefore, today's filing includes a revised Societal Benefits Charge of 0.5895 cents per kWh, including Sales and Use Tax, to be implemented for service rendered on and after July 1, 2024.

Please note that the Company is making this filing solely in electronic form pursuant to the Board's directive in its Emergency Order dated March 19, 2020 in BPU Docket No. EO20030254.

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

**No. 33 SOCIETAL BENEFITS CHARGE (“SBC”)**

The SBC shall be applied to the kWh usage on the bills of all customers served under this Schedule. The SBC shall include costs, including current costs and any refund or recovery of prior period over- or under-collection balances, related to:

- (1) demand-side management (“DSM”), including the costs associated with DSM programs and DSM bidding programs;
- (2) Clean Energy Program, (“CEP”);
- (3) Universal Service Fund and Lifeline; and
- (4) Uncollectible Expense

The SBC to be effective on and after the date indicated below shall be set at 0.5895 cents per kWh, including sales and use tax (“SUT”). The SBC includes the following rate components:

The difference between actual costs incurred by the Company for the SBC components described above and SBC recoveries will be deferred, with interest, for future recovery in accordance with the Company’s Plan for Resolution of Proceedings approved by the Board in its Summary Order dated July 28, 1999 and Final Order dated July 22, 2002 in Docket Nos. EO97070464, EO97070465 and EO97070466.
