The Office of Cable Television and Telecommunications ("OCTV&T") is in receipt of the above captioned Petition for Renewal Certificate of Approval and attached application for the Borough of Hamburg ("Borough"). The following is a request for additional information the OCTV&T would like the company to furnish prior to the completion of our review:

- Section IV. System Design Subsection 3: This section requires, in part, the company to provide information as to the number, cable channel designation, type of access channels and their manner of operation and channel sharing. Staff notes that this section indicates that Access and Local Origination programming will be located on Channel 10 and Educational Access will be located on Channel 20. Please provide an updated application page that indicates what type of Access channel will be shared with Local Origination programming on Channel 10
- 2. Section IV. System Design Subsection 6: This section requires the company to describe in narrative form, any other services available to subscribers. Such descriptions shall include, but not be limited to, the applicant's capability to contract with the community for such services as emergency override, interconnection of schools or local government offices, and availability of equipment and technical advice to the community. Staff notes that this section of the application does not list the free services that the company is willing to provide to the Borough. Staff notes that the Ordinance adopted on July 6, 2022 states in Section 10 FREE SERVICES, that the company shall, upon written request, provide free of charge, standard installation and monthly cable television services to all State or locally accredited Public Schools and all municipal public libraries, as well as municipal buildings located within the municipality. Please provide an updated application page that lists the free services that the company shall provide upon request.
