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PETITION FOR RENEWAL OF CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL

Service Electric Cable T.V. of Hunterdon, Inc., (hereinafter "Petitioner") a cable television company of the State of New Jersey, with its principal place of business being located at 2260 Avenue A, Bethlehem, Pennsylvania 18017, says in support of its petition for the Renewal of a Certificate of Approval:

- 1. Petitioner is a cable television company currently authorized to provide cable television reception service and communication services in six Hunterdon County municipalities and in six Warren County municipalities. One of the Hunterdon County municipalities is the Township of Frenchtown (hereinafter "Municipality," "Borough" or "Frenchtown"), the subject of this petition.
- 2. Petitioner holds a Certificate of Approval (hereinafter "Certificate") for the operation of a cable television and communications system in Frenchtown, issued by the Board of Public Utilities (hereinafter "Board") on October 28, 2009 in Docket No.CE09050428. That Certificate expires on October 28, 2024.
- 3. That Certificate incorporated a municipal consent ordinance that had been adopted by the Municipality on or about May 6, 2009 and identified as Ordinance number 662. That Ordinance granted a fifteen-year consent to Petitioner.

- 4. Petitioner filed its Application for Renewal of Municipal Consent in the Township ("Application for Consent") on October 25, 2023.
- 5. On February 7, 2024, the Township held a public hearing on the Application for Consent and on March 6, 2024 passed a resolution as follows:

That the Borough of Frenchtown, subject to the negotiation of a mutually acceptable Renewal Municipal Consent Ordinance, consents to renew the cable television franchise held by Service Electric Cable TV of Hunterdon, Inc.

See Attachment 1 hereto.

- 6. On April 4, 2024, the Frenchtown Borough Attorney sent a draft ordinance to the Office of Cable Television and Telecommunications ("Office") via e-mail "for its review, comment and approval" as required by N.J.A.C. 14:18-11.18. The terms of that draft ordinance would provide Petitioner with a 15-year consent. See Attachment 2 hereto.
- 7. N.J.A.C. 14:18-11.18 requires the municipality to introduce and proceed on such a cable television consent ordinance only "after approval of the Office."
- 8. To date, the Office has not issued any "review, comment and approval" of the draft ordinance.
- 9. Consistent with the requirements of N.J.A.C. § 14:18-11.18, the Borough has not proceeded with introduction or adoption of a consent ordinance, as the Office has not provided its "review, comment and approval".
- 10. The NJ Statutes (N.J.S.A. § 48:5A-25) provide:

No CATV company whose municipal consent or renewal thereof has expired shall be authorized to continue its operations unless prior to such expiration it has obtained a certificate of approval from the board authorizing such continued operation, except that such a CATV company which has initiated proceedings to obtain such certification from the board prior to the expiration of the municipal consent may continue its operations pending the final disposition of such proceedings.

Emphasis added.

- 11. Petitioner files this petition at this time prior to the October 28, 2024 expiration of its franchise in Frenchtown. The petition is based upon the inaction by the municipality on the ordinance, which in turn appears to be based upon the inaction by the Office on the Borough's draft ordinance. Nevertheless, Petitioner files this petition to initiate proceedings for a Certificate of Approval to protect itself and its customers from any claim of the expiration of its authority to operate pursuant to N.J.S.A. § 48:5A-25.
- 12. Petitioner desires to work with the Borough and would accept a municipal consent and Certificate of Approval based upon the terms of the draft ordinance submitted by the Borough on April 4, 2024.
- 13. As required by N.J.A.C. 14:18-12.2, the Petitioner is providing the information required in the standard form issued by the Office, which includes the information required by N.J.A.C. 14:18-11.2. See Attachment 3 hereto. The map attached as appendix to attachment 3 reflects the limited area of the municipality not served, which is subject to the Line Extension Policy. That policy is in appendix C to Attachment 3 and uses 16 homes per mile as reflected in appendix E to attachment 3. Petitioner notes that the map is redacted in the Public Version of this filing.

WHEREFOR, BASED ON THE FOREGOING, PETITIONER REQUESTS THAT THE BOARD ISSUE AN ORDER PROVIDING IT WITH A RENEWAL OF ITS CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL IN THE BOROUGH OF FRENCHTOWN, HUNTERDON COUNTY, UNDER TERMS CONSISTENT WITH THE DRAFT ORDINANCE SUBMITTED BY THE BOROUGH (ATTACHMENT 2 HERETO).

RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF FRENCHTOWN, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, CONSENTING TO THE RENEWAL OF THE SERVICE ELECTRIC CABLE TV OF HUNTERDON, INC., CABLE TELEVISION FRANCHISE WITHIN THE BOROUGH

WHEREAS, Service Electric Cable TV of Hunterdon, Inc. is the holder of a cable television franchise within the Borough of Frenchtown; and

WHEREAS, Service Electric's cable television franchise expires on October 28, 2024; and

WHEREAS, on October 24, 2023, Service Electric filed with the Borough Clerk an Application for a Traditional Municipal Consent Cable Television Franchise; and

WHEREAS, on December 11, 2023, and January 26, 2024, the Borough published in the Courier News a Legal Notice informing the public that the Borough Common Council would hold a public hearing regarding the Application of Service Electric on February 7, 2024; and

WHEREAS, on February 7, 2024, the Borough Common Council held a public hearing during which Service Electric made a public presentation requesting a fifteen (15) year renewal and that the Borough Common Council adopt a Municipal Consent Resolution at that meeting; and

WHEREAS, Service Electric requested during both the public

hearing and in a February 21, 2024 letter that because the Borough had "granted Comcast of Northwest New Jersey, LLC a 15-year consent to operate a CATV system in the Borough, including access to the public rights of way. Thus, in addition to the record of evidence, basic fairness, due process, and equal protection and treatment under the law support, factually and legally, SECTV receiving a 15-year renewal of its CATV consent in the Borough"; and

WHEREAS, the Borough disagrees with Service Electric's position that because Comcast received a 15-year consent for a system-wide franchise, Service Electric is also entitled to a 15-year consent for a traditional franchise; and

WHEREAS, the Borough believes that Service Electric and Comcast are not similarly situated because Service Electric operates under a traditional franchise, with the terms and conditions of the franchise negotiated and memorialized in a Renewal Municipal Consent Ordinance, and Comcast is in the process of applying to the Board of Public Utilities for a system-wide franchise which, if granted, will result in an "overbuild" enhancing competition for cable television and internet service within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough finds and concludes that Service Electric is not entitled to an automatic 15-year consent because one was granted to Comcast; and

WHEREAS, Service Electric and the Borough have been negotiating a Renewal Municipal Consent Ordinance, but have not reached a mutually acceptable Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding that a mutually acceptable Renewal Municipal Consent Ordinance has not been negotiated, the Borough desires to renew Service Electric's cable television franchise; and

WHEREAS, the Borough reserves the ability to negotiate the Renewal Municipal Consent Ordinance, including the term, and encourages Service Electric to continue to negotiate with the Borough for a Renewal Ordinance.

WHEREAS, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Common Council of the Borough of Frenchtown, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. That the Borough of Frenchtown hereby finds and concludes that there is a material difference between a traditional franchise and a system-wide franchise that does not require the cable companies operating under different franchises to be treated the same.
- 2. That the Borough of Frenchtown, subject to the negotiation of a mutually acceptable Renewal Municipal Consent Ordinance, consents to renew the cable television franchise held by Service Electric Cable TV of Hunterdon, Inc.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FRENCHTOWN, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY GRANTING RENEWAL OF MUNICIPAL

CONSENT TO SERVICE ELECTRIC CABLE TV OF HUNTERDON, INC. TO CONSTRUCT, CONNECT, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN A CABLE TELEVISION AND COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM IN THE BOROUGH OF FRENCHTOWN, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Frenchtown, that Chapter 22 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Frenchtown titled "Cable Television" is hereby repealed and replaced with a new Chapter 22 also titled "Cable Television", as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE OF THE ORDINANCE

The Borough hereby grants to Service Electric Cable TV of Hunterdon, Inc.("SECTVH") renewal of its non-exclusive Municipal Consent to place in, upon, across, above, over and under highways, streets, alleys, sidewalks, easements, public ways and public places in the Borough, poles, wires, cables, underground conduits, manholes and other television conductors, fixtures, apparatus and equipment as may be necessary for the construction, operation and maintenance in the Borough of a cable television and communications system.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS

For this Ordinance, the following terms, phrases, words, and their derivations shall have the meaning given herein. Such meaning or definition of terms is supplemental to those definitions of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") rules and regulations, 47 <u>C.F.R.</u> Subsection 76.1 *et seq.*, and the Cable Communications Policy Act, 47 <u>U.S.C.</u> Section 521 *et seq.*, as amended, and the Cable Television Act, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 48:5A-1 *et seq.*, and shall in no way be construed to broaden, alter, or conflict with the federal and state definitions:

- a. "Municipality" or "Borough" is the Borough of Frenchtown, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey.
- b. "Company" is the grantee of rights under this Ordinance and is known as Service Electric Cable TV of Hunterdon, Inc.("SECTVH").
- c. "Act" or "Cable Television Act" is Chapter 186 of the General Laws of New Jersey, and subsequent amendments thereto, N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1, et seq.
- d. "FCC" is the Federal Communications Commission.

- e. "Board" or "BPU" is the Board of Public Utilities, State of New Jersey.
- f. "Office" or "OCTV" is the Office of Cable Television of the Board.
- g. "Basic Cable Service" means the lowest level of which includes the retransmission of local television broadcast signals as defined by the FCC.
- "Application" is SECTVH's Application for Municipal Consent.
- h. "Rate Schedule" means the prices and applicable terms and conditions reflected in the SECTVH Schedule of Prices, Rates, Terms and Conditions filed with the Office of Cable Television pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-11, which may be revised by the Company from time-to-time during the term of the municipal consent granted herein.

SECTION 3. STATEMENT OF FINDINGS

Public hearings conducted by the Borough, concerning the renewal of Municipal Consent herein granted to the Company were held after proper public notice pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Act and the regulations of the Board adopted pursuant thereto. Said hearings, having been fully open to the public, and the Borough, having received at said public hearings all comments regarding the qualifications of the Company to receive this renewal of Municipal Consent, the Borough hereby finds that the Company possesses the necessary legal, technical, character, financial and other qualifications and that the Company's operating and construction arrangements are adequate and feasible.

SECTION 4. DURATION OF FRANCHISE

- A. The non-exclusive Municipal Consent granted herein shall extend for fifteen (15) years from the date of the issuance of a renewal Certificate of Approval by the Board.
- B. If there exists a period following the expiration of the Borough's consent Ordinance 622, Frenchtown's Cable Television Ordinance, until such time that a decision is made the Board, the Company shall petition the Board for a Certificate of Approval authorizing continued operation during any such period.
- C. In the event that the Municipality shall find that the Company has not substantially complied with the material terms and conditions of this Ordinance with respect to matters under the exclusive control of the Company, the Municipality shall have the right to petition the OCTV, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-47, for appropriate action, including modification and/or termination of the Certificate of Approval; provided however, that the Municipality shall first have given the Company written notice of all alleged instances of non-compliance and provide an opportunity to cure noncompliance within ninety (90) days of such notice or such additional period as may be appropriate where the cause of the noncompliance is beyond the reasonable control of the company.
- D. Notification of impending transfer. SECTVH shall give the municipality thirty (30) days notice of any impending transfer of the franchise to any other entity, person, or otherwise.

SECTION 5. FRANCHISE FEE

- A. Pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Act, the Company shall, during each year of operation under the consent granted herein, pay to the Borough two percent (2%) of the gross revenues from all recurring charges in the nature of subscription fees paid by subscribers for cable television reception service in the Borough or any higher amount permitted by the Act or otherwise allowable by law, whichever is greater.
- B. If applicable law hereafter permits a larger franchise fee to be collected, but does not fix the amount thereof, the municipality and SECTVH shall negotiate in good faith with respect to the amount thereof, which amount shall be due and payable from the date that the franchise fee was increased by said law.

SECTION 6. FRANCHISE TERRITORY

The consent granted under this Ordinance to the renewal of the franchise shall apply to the entirety of the Borough and any property subsequently annexed hereto.

SECTION 7. EXTENSION OF SERVICE

- A. The Company shall be required to proffer service along any public right-of-way to any person's residence or business located in all areas of the franchise territory as described on the Wiring Map attached hereto as Schedule A, at tariffed rates for standard and non-standard installations. Any additional line extension of the system shall be in accordance with OCTV Line Extension Policy ("LEP"). For purposes of the LEP, the minimum density of homes per mile shall be sixteen (16). To the extent not inconsistent with applicable federal or state law, SECTV installation charges and line extension policy is as set forth in its application.
- B. The Company has modified its Application as regards its line drop policy to reflect that the Company shall extend its plant from public rights-of-way to all residences and businesses within three hundred (300) aerial or underground feet of the operator's existing plant, or 16 homes per mile, at no cost beyond the normal installation rate. SECTVH shall also extend its plant after the first three hundred (300) feet of installation to subscribers from public roads at rates listed in the Rate Schedule and subsection C below. SECTVH will also extend its plant along private roads under the same conditions as set forth above. If the density of homes along a private road does not meet the threshold under the Company's line extension policy, the property owner(s) shall share the cost of the line extension. Property owners seeking such extensions shall be responsible for obtaining and providing easements at their own expense to be given to the Company, where necessary to provide such an extension of service.
- C. To the extent a nonstandard installation, installation in the public right-of-way or installation along private roads beyond the requirements of the LEP, or extension beyond 300 feet for a line drop to a customer is not addressed by rates in the Rate Schedule, the installation shall be done at the Company's unitized or actual costs for materials and labor employed in the installation, including overheads directly attributable to the work.

SECTION 8. CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS

- A. Restoration: In the event that the Company or its agents shall disturb any pavement, street surfaces, sidewalks, driveways, or other surface in the nature topography within the Municipality, the Company shall, at its sole expense, restore and replace such places or things so disturbed in as good a condition as existed prior to the commencement of said work.
- B. Relocation: If at any time during the period of this consent, the Municipality shall alter or change the grade of any street, alley or other way or place the Company, upon reasonable notice by the Municipality, shall remove, re-lay, or relocate its equipment, at the expense of the Company.
- C. Temporary Removal of Cables: The Company shall, upon request of the Municipality at the Company's expense, temporarily raise, lower, or remove its lines to facilitate the moving of buildings or machinery or in other like circumstances. Whenever the request is made by, for, or on behalf of private parties, the cost will be borne by those private parties.
- D. Removal or Trimming of Trees: During the exercise of its rights and privileges under this franchise, the Company shall, upon thirty (30) days written notice to the Municipality and the written consent of the Municipality, have the authority to trim trees upon and overhanging streets, alleys, sidewalks or other public places of the Municipality so as to prevent the branches of such trees from coming in contact with the wires and cable of the Company. Such trimming shall be only to the extent necessary to maintain proper clearance of the Company's wire and cables.

SECTION 9. CUSTOMER SERVICE

In providing services to its customers, the Company shall comply with <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 14:18-1, *et seq.* and all applicable state and federal statutes and regulations, including, but not limited to technical standards for the transmission of television signals, transmission quality or facilities and equipment. The Company shall strive to meet or exceed all voluntary company and industry standards in the delivery of customer service and shall be prepared to report on it to the community upon written request of the Borough.

- a. The Company shall continue to comply fully with all applicable state and federal statues and regulations regarding credits for outages, the reporting of same to regulatory agencies and notification of same to customers. Every effort shall be made by SECTVH to repair service outages within six (6) hours of their being reported and the Company being permitted to undertake such repair. SECTVH shall reimburse each affected subscriber for the period of any outage as required by N.J.A.C. 14:18-3.5 and any other Board of Public Utility Rules requiring and/or prescribing the formula for outage credits.
- b. The Company shall continue to fully comply with all applicable state and federal statues and regulations regarding the availability of devices for the hearing impaired and the notification of same to customers.

- c. The Company shall use reasonable efforts to meet or exceed voluntary standards for telephone accessibility developed by the National Cable Television Association (NCTA) except as they may be modified by the Office.
- d. Nothing herein shall impair the right of any subscriber or the Municipality to express any comment with respect to telephone accessibility to the Complaint Officer or impair the right of the Complaint Officer to take any action that is permitted under law.
- e. SECTVH shall provide a toll-free telephone number for customer calls, said number to be included on all monthly bills. All equipment provided by SECTVH shall be serviced, repaired, or replaced by SECTVH through service calls made directly to the individual subscriber's location if required by the nature of the call or in another mutually agreed upon manner.
- f. SECTVH shall notify the Municipality or its designee at least thirty (30) days in advance of any proposed rate increase and shall publish all its rates for all subscriber services to each customer in the manner consistent with the requirements of the Office
- g. SECTVH shall give due consideration to programming preferences expressed by customers. Further, SECTVH shall provide subscribers in the Borough with at least the same broad categories of programming, in approximately the same quality, as are now provided and which appear in the Application.
- h. SECTVH will always endeavor to keep rates reasonably comparable to other area systems on a cost-per-channel basis, and the rates charged to the subscribers of Frenchtown Borough shall not be higher than the rates charged to any other subscriber of SECTVH within its other franchised municipalities.
- i. SECTVH shall provide reasonable notice informing subscribers of telephone numbers, addresses and procedures to keep them informed of all cable television services available from SECTVH.
- j. SECTVH shall comply with any state law or regulation and shall use its best efforts to comply with any guideline with respect to maintaining space for a statewide interconnect channel.

SECTION 10. MUNICIPAL COMPLAINT OFFICER

The Office of Cable Television is hereby designed as the Complaint Officer for the Municipality pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:5A-26(b). All complaints shall be received and processed in accordance with N.J.A.C. 14:17-6.5. The Municipality shall have the right to request copies of records and reports pertaining to complaints by Borough customers from the OCTV.

SECTION 11. LOCAL OFFICE

- A. During the term of this franchise, and any renewal thereof, the Company shall maintain a local business office or agent for the purpose of receiving, investigating, and resolving all complaints regarding the quality of service, equipment malfunctions and similar matters.
- B. Such a local business office shall be open during normal business hours and in no event less than 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Telephone responses for such purposes as mentioned herein will be provided by the Company's employees, representatives, or agents twenty-four (24) hours per day.
- C. The telephone number and address of the local office shall be listed in applicable telephone directories and in correspondence from the Company to the customer. The telephone number for the local office shall utilize an exchange that is a non-toll call for Borough residents.

SECTION 12. PERFORMANCE BONDS

During the life of the franchise the Company shall give to the municipality a bond in the amount of twenty-five thousand (\$25,000.00) dollars. Such bond shall be to insure the faithful performance of all undertakings of the Company as represented in its application for municipal consent incorporated herein. The Municipality reserves the right by Resolution to require a reasonable increase in the amount of said bond, subject to review by the OCTV and approval by the Board.

SECTION 13. SUBSCRIBER RATES

The rates of the Company shall be subject to regulation as permitted by federal and state law. If applicable law is hereafter amended to permit the exercise of regulatory power over rates by municipalities, the Municipality reserves the right to exercise the maximum power permitted by law at such time said law becomes effective.

SECTION 14. PUBLIC, EDUCATIONAL AND GOVERNMENTAL ACCESS

The Company shall continue to provide the installation of (1) outlet and basic monthly service to public buildings within the Borough, including the Municipal Building at 29 Second Street, Police Department at 27 Second Street, Fire Department at 31 Second Street, Department of Public Works at 86 River Road, Sewer Department at 43 River Road, Park at 1 Creek Road, Frenchtown Borough Elementary School at 902 Harrison Street.

SECTION 15. ADDITIONAL COMMITMENTS BY THE COMPANY

A. SECTVH will maintain, at a minimum, the level of service currently provided.

B. SECTVH representatives shall appear upon reasonable written request of the Borough, at a public hearing of the Common Council to discuss matters pertaining to the provision of cable service to residents of the Borough and other related issues as the Borough and Company may see fit.

SECTION 16. EMERGENCY USES

- A. The Company shall be required to fully comply with all applicable federal and state statutes and regulations rules and regulations governing the implementation, operation, and testing of the Emergency Alert System ("EAS").
- B. The Company shall in no way be held liable for any injury suffered by the municipality or any other person during an emergency, if for any reason the Municipality is unable to make full use of the cable television system as contemplated herein.

SECTION 17. LIABILITY INSURANCE

The Company shall always maintain a comprehensive general liability insurance policy with a single limit amount of \$1,000,000 covering liability for any death, personal injury, property damages or other liability arising out of its construction and operation of the cable television system, and an excess liability (or "umbrella") policy in the amount of \$3,000,000. The Municipality shall be named as an additional insured under said policy.

SECTION 18. REDUCED RATES FOR SENIOR CITIZENS

The Company has agreed to implement a senior citizen's discount rate in the amount of 10% of the monthly Basic Cable Service rate to any person sixty-two (62) years of age or older who subscribes to cable services. Such subscribers must meet the income eligibility and residency requirements of the Pharmaceutical Assistance to Aged and Disabled pursuant to N.J.S.A. 30:4D-21. The Company has agreed to apply the same discount rate to the disabled with the same PAAD eligibility requirements.

SECTION 19. INCORPORATION OF THE APPLICATION

All the commitments and statements contained in the Application and any amendment thereto submitted in writing to the Municipality by the Company, except as modified herein, are binding upon the Company as terms and conditions of this Municipal Consent. The Application and any other relevant writings submitted by the Company shall be considered a part of this Ordinance and made a part hereof by reference if it does not conflict with state or federal law. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or other agreements between the Borough and the Company that conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared invalid and superseded.

SECTION 20. SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court or federal or state agency of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and its validity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

SECTION 21. CONSISTENCY WITH FUTURE FEDERAL AND STATE STATUTES, REGULATIONS, RULES, AND ORDERS.

Should any of the federal or state statutes, regulations, rules, orders, or pronouncements applicable to the regulation of cable television be modified in any way, such modifications, to the extent that they embody required terms and conditions and meaningfully can be incorporated into this ordinance, shall be so incorporated, consistent with any applicable effective dates specified in such modification. To the extent that any such modification places limits on permissible terms and conditions and any provision of this ordinance becomes invalid by virtue of such modification, the preceding Section 20 shall apply.

SECTION 22. REPEAL

Any prior Ordinance of this Borough granting consents to the Company or any of its predecessors is hereby repealed in its entirety as of the effective date of this Ordinance. Furthermore, all resolutions and ordinances regarding such consents within the Borough are repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 23. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect upon the publication thereof, the municipality receiving written notification from SECTVH that it accepts the provisions of this ordinance and the issuance of a Renewal Certificate of Approval from the BPU.

STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Adoption of Regulations of Office of Cable Television

The Regulations of the Office of Cable Television, Board of Public Utilities, State of New Jersey, are hereby adopted by reference thereto and are incorporated herein as though fully set forth, except that those provisions of the Regulations which are preempted by Federal Regulations are specifically excluded and not adopted.

2. Ownership of Facilities

All facilities and equipment, including but not limited to amplifiers, converters, digital tuners, junction boxes, cable and wire, furnished by the company appurtenant to the provision of cable television service remains the property of the company and are furnished subject to the following conditions:

- A. Such facilities and equipment shall be reasonably used by the subscriber and shall be returned to the Company upon demand or at the termination of service in good condition, fair wear and tear excepted.
- B. Subscriber provided equipment and facilities are not authorized to be connected to Company facilities except in accordance with Section 3 hereafter.
- C. Subscribers shall not connect, rearrange, disconnect or remove appurtenant equipment provided by the Company except upon the written consent of the Company.

3. Subscriber Provided Facilities

Subscriber provided equipment may be connected to the facilities of the Company only in accordance with the following provisions:

- A. Such subscriber provided equipment shall not cause any interference with the provision of service to other subscribers; damage in any way the facilities of the Company; or enable the subscriber to avail himself of services provided by the Company without paying therefore. Cable wire must meet minimum Company, OCTV and/or FCC signal leakage standards, as applicable.
- B. No subscriber provided equipment may be connected to the Company's facilities without the specific prior written approval of the Company. Such approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.
- C. The granting of approval for the connection of subscriber provided equipment does not constitute any representation on the part of the Company regarding the compatibility of such equipment with the Company's facilities. The Company shall not be responsible to the subscriber for damages arising out of mistake, improper use or any other cause, to the facilities of the subscriber so attached. Approval by the Company does not constitute any release to the subscriber for damages which may occur to the Company's facilities by reason of the connection of such subscriber provided facilities.
- D. Any use of the Company's facilities not reasonably contemplated shall be permitted only with the written consent of the Company.
- E. Maintenance service of subscriber provided facilities, including television receivers, is the responsibility of the subscriber. The Company does not provide such service, nor shall it bear the costs of such service.
- F. Subscriber provided equipment shall not cause signal leakage beyond FCC limits. Subscriber shall be responsible for any such leakage.

4. Maintenance of Facilities

The Company will maintain its facilities at its own cost where such maintenance is required by fair wear and tear. Where maintenance service is occasioned by the abuse of the subscriber, a charge may be made for the cost of such maintenance service.

5. Liability of Service Electric Cable T.V. of Hunterdon, Inc.

The Liability of the Company resulting from interruptions of service shall in no way exceed the amount equivalent to the proportionate charge to the subscriber for the period of time when such service shall be unavailable, as a result of failure of company equipment or the amount required by law to be refunded to the subscriber. Credit shall not be given for acts of God, utility company failure to provide power, vehicle accidents, etc. The Company shall not be liable for damages for any accident or any injury occasioned by its facilities when such accident or injury is not due to the negligence of the Company.

6. Trip Charge in Lieu of Disconnect

A subscriber that is to be disconnected may avoid disconnection and reconnection charges by paying a trip charge fee prior to disconnect along with any outstanding balances that are due.

7. Late Payment Charge

A late charge of 1-1/2% will be added to amount in arrears over 30 days.

In calculating the number of homes in any given area, the total number of homes within 200* feet on either side of the proposed trunk line shall be included. In any case, the company shall extend its plant along public rights of way to:

- 1. All residences and businesses within 300 aerial feet of the operator's existing plant at no cost beyond the normal installation rate.
- 2. All residences and businesses with 300 underground feet of the operator's plant at no cost beyond the normal installation rate.

 The minimum HPM that the company actually constructs in the system or municipality is the minimum number of homes which the company has historically constructed at its own cost. This is a function of the operator's break-even point and its rate of return. Unbuilt systems will use the primary service area rather than construction.

The operator's installation policies shall apply to construction beyond the public right of way.

Detailed accounting and/or financial information to support the minimum HPM shall be supplied to the Office for its approval in such form as required. The minimum HPM shall be updated as appropriate.

When a request for service is received, and unless good cause is shown, cable companies shall:

- 1. Provide a written estimate within 30 days of such request.
- 2. Begin construction within 60 days of receipt of any deposit monies from potential subscribers.
- 3. Complete construction within 6 months of receipt of deposit monies from potential subscribers.
- 4. Inform each home passed along the extension of the potential costs for subscribers.

Subscribers who pay for an extension shall be entitled to rebates in the following manner:

- 1. If the company acquires new subscribers subsequent to the initial calculation of step five above, the formula will be adjusted and those who have previously paid for the extension will be entitled to an appropriate rebate. In no event shall the amount of the rebate exceed the subscriber's contribution.
- 2. The company shall keep accurate records of the cost of the extension, the amounts paid by subscribers and any appropriate adjustments.
- 3. The company shall notify subscribers in the extension of the rights and responsibilities concerning the extension.
- 4. Once an individual dwelling has paid its share of the extension cost future reconnections or installations shall be made at the company's standard rates.
- 5. After a period of five years from the installation of the first dwelling unit in the extension no further adjustments shall be made. Installations after five years shall be be at the company's standard rate.
- 6. Once a subscriber is installed, that person shall not normally be entitled to a refund of any monies paid for the installations, except in accordance with the rebate procedure outlined in this policy.

Definitions

PRIMARY SERVICE AREA

The primary service area (PSA) can be entire municipality but in many instances with PSA is a limited area within a community outside of which a line extension policy may apply. The PSA is depicted by a franchise map and narrative, presented and recorded during the franchise proceedings. It normally remains a fixed geographic area throughout the life of the franchise.

LINE EXTENSTION SURVEY

Potential subscribers residing outside the PSA who request service are entitled to an estimate of their share of the cost to secure service. When conducting a survey and estimating costs a cable company should factor in all potential subscribers who could practicably be included in the extension and give consideration to apparent residential construction in areas contiguous to the proposed extension.
